Many thanks to the Match Committee - Graeme Harper and Jim Tait for the smooth running of our club competitions.


We have several competitions ahead of us for the remainder of 2025. Members are also enjoying the sunnier pistes thanks to the removal of the trees on the west side of club grounds.


