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ROBBERIES OF CARRIERS & MAIL THEFT

Project Safe Delivery

- Use of tools and resources.
- Coordination with prosecutors.
- Engagement with law enforcement partners.
- Communication with USPS employees.

- Increased employee safety, awareness, and engagement.
- Enhanced law enforcement capacity.
- Expand partnerships with key stakeholders.



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COUNTERFEIT POSTAGE

- Development of new technology.
- Support USPS with fraud identification and mitigation.
