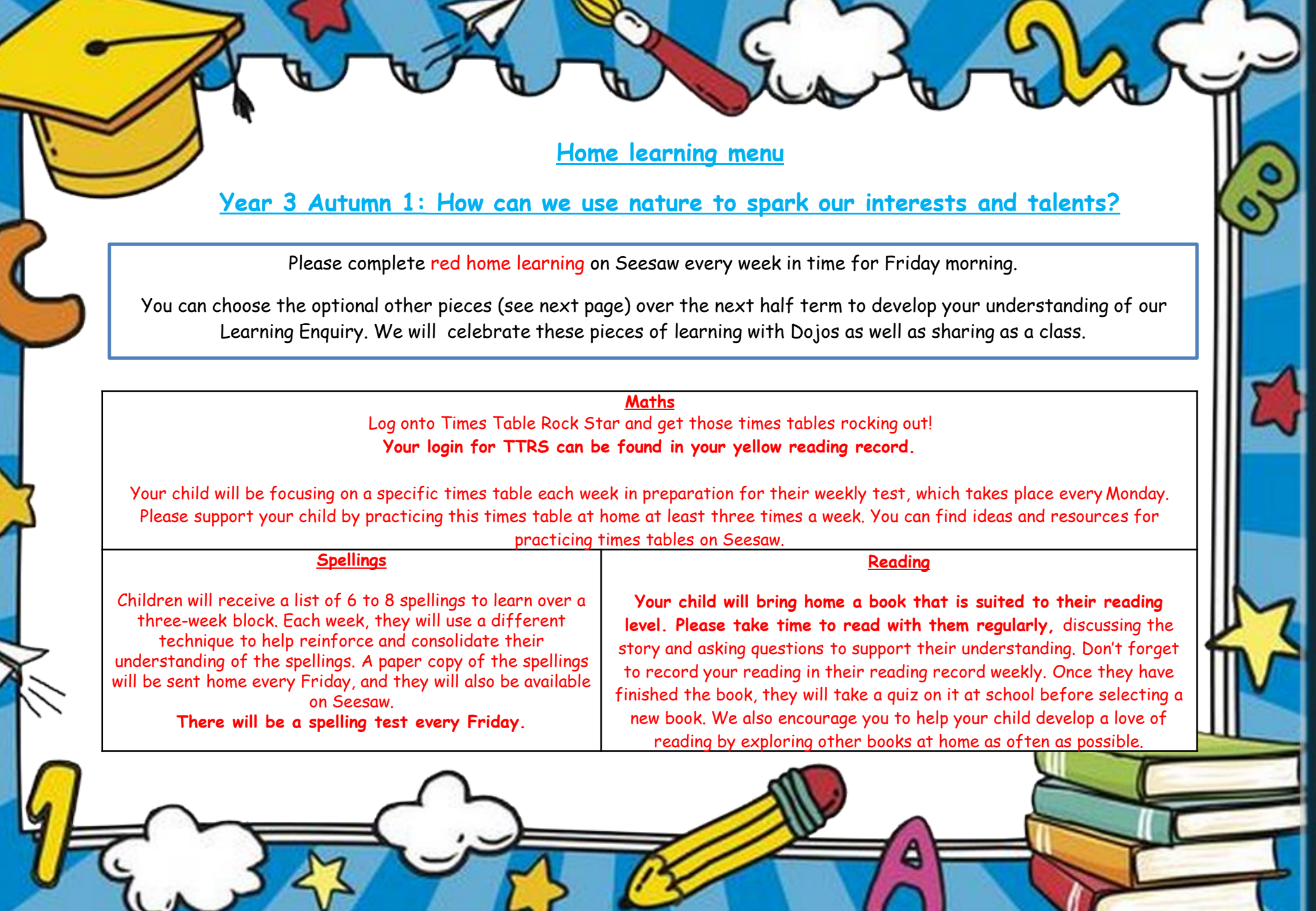

Maths

Your child will be focusing on a specific times table each week in preparation for their weekly test, which takes place every Monday.

Please support your child by practicing this times table at home at least three times a week. You can find ideas and resources for practicing times tables on Seesaw.

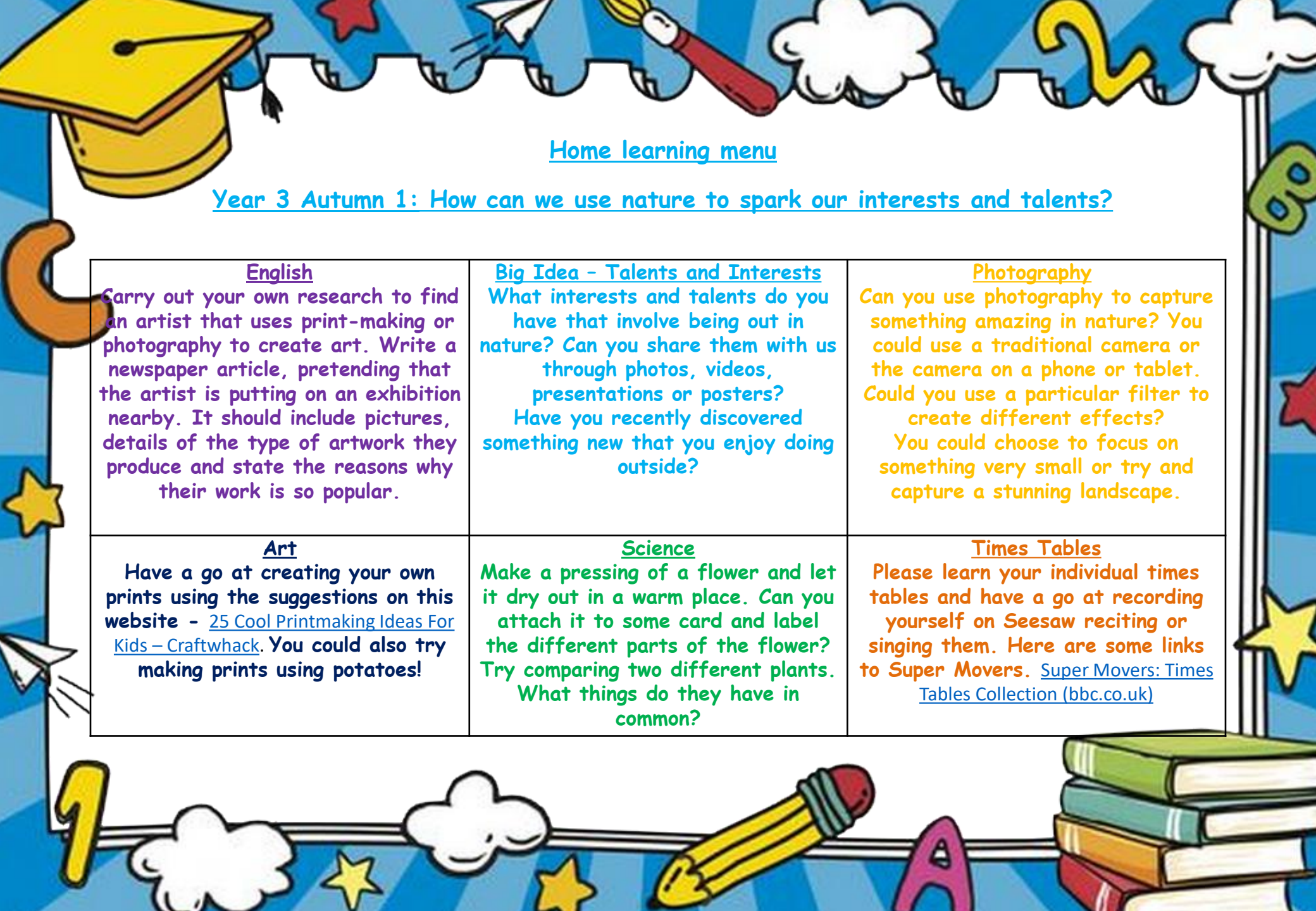
Spellings

Children will receive a list of 6 to 8 spellings to learn over a three-week block. Each week, they will use a different technique to help reinforce and consolidate their understanding of the spellings. A paper copy of the spellings will be sent home every Friday, and they will also be available on Seesaw.

There will be a spelling test every Friday.

Reading

Your child will bring home a book that is suited to their reading level. Please take time to read with them regularly, discussing the story and asking questions to support their understanding. Don't forget to record your reading in their reading record weekly. Once they have finished the book, they will take a quiz on it at school before selecting a new book. We also encourage you to help your child develop a love of reading by exploring other books at home as often as possible.

English

Carry out your own research to find an artist that uses print-making or photography to create art. Write a newspaper article, pretending that the artist is putting on an exhibition nearby. It should include pictures, details of the type of artwork they produce and state the reasons why their work is so popular.

Big Idea - Talents and Interests

What interests and talents do you have that involve being out in nature? Can you share them with us through photos, videos, presentations or posters?
Have you recently discovered something new that you enjoy doing outside?

Photography

Can you use photography to capture something amazing in nature? You could use a traditional camera or the camera on a phone or tablet. Could you use a particular filter to create different effects?
You could choose to focus on something very small or try and capture a stunning landscape.

Art

Science

Make a pressing of a flower and let it dry out in a warm place. Can you attach it to some card and label the different parts of the flower? Try comparing two different plants. What things do they have in common?
