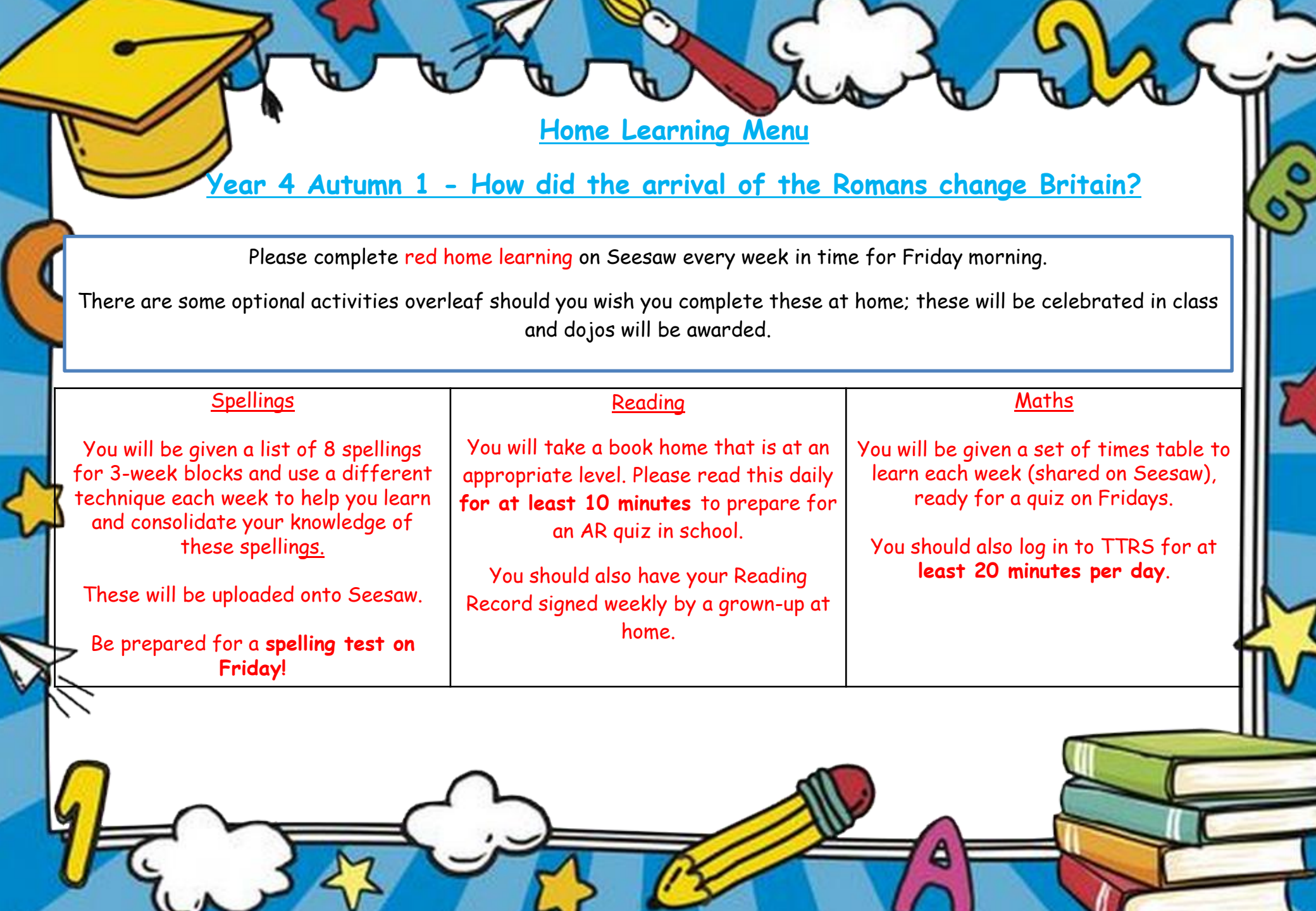




Home Learning Menu
