Year 1 Learning Enquiry Fieldtrip

Friday 26th – Rabbits Class

This term, your child will have an exciting opportunity to investigate their local area to consolidate and deepen their Geography and Science learning. We will be completing activities along the way to help us with this term's Learning Enquiry.

During the day, the children will walk around our local area towards the beach. They will use maps and will identify human and physical features around our locality. They will also be identifying and naming our local wildlife, and complete some beach conservation, starting to think about our responsibilities to look after the animal life around us. The children will finish the day back in class and share their ideas, making plans for how they can help a mermaid with her quest to protect our local area and amazing wildlife over the half term.

Children will need to come into school dressed in uniform, including a jumper or cardigan with a waterproof coat, and we recommend wellies if possible.

During the visit, we require small groups of children to be supported by adults as we walk and engage in activities. We will always stay together as a group, but we are asking for some additional helpers to support us on the trip. Safety for the children is our priority, so the trip is dependent on having the support of additional adults.
