


Dear Parents and Carers,

World Book Day is coming!

On Thursday 5th March, we would love for the children to come into school wearing either their favourite cosy pyjamas or dressed as their favourite book character. As part of our celebration of reading, it would be great if your child could donate a book to add to our ever-growing school library (please don't buy any new books, a well-loved one from home is perfect!)



This World Book Day, we'll be celebrating our love of reading through a focused book study of *Shh! We Have a Plan* by Chris Haughton. Using this engaging and visually-rich story, children will explore characters, plot, and language, and use the book as inspiration for their own writing. Our aim is to promote writing in a meaningful way, showing children how great stories can spark ideas, creativity and a real enjoyment of putting their thoughts into words.



If children are already familiar with the book, or would like to join in creatively, they are very welcome to dress up as a character from the story on the day.



Rock Up and Read

We would like to also continue with our 'Rock Up and Read' sessions as they were very successful last term! This term's session will take place as part of World Book Day. All children will have the opportunity to read with their adult at 2.45pm in their classrooms. Please *rock up* to your child's usual gate at 2:40pm, ready to *read* at 2:45pm! If you have more than one child attending our school, there will be opportunity for you to visit them within the time allocated.

World Book Day Lunch


