Re: Year 2 Exeter Trip

Year 2's new Learning Enquiry next half term will be all about the Great Fire of London. Excitingly, we will be going on a trip to see a real Tudor-style building and learn all about the architecture of the time as part of our history and DT work.

We will be travelling to Exeter by train and visiting St Nicholas Priory in the city centre. The cost of the trip will be £11.00 per child, payable via Arbor.

Moles class will be going on Wednesday 29th April and Squirrels class will be going on Thursday 30th April.

You will need to confirm your permission for your child to attend this trip via Arbor.

To make the most of our time at the priory, we are asking parents and carers to **drop their children off at Torquay train station at 9am** (there will be a staff presence at the station from 8:40am). To ensure we do not miss the train, we are asking parents to be as prompt as possible. **Children can be collected from the train station at 3:30pm** (or, for those going to Afterschool Club, staff will ensure they get there safely).

If you are unable to drop your child off at the station or your child is in Breakfast Club, please inform the school as soon as possible so that we can make other arrangements to get your child to the station.

Children will be provided with a packed lunch and will need to bring a bag in order to carry it with them, along with plenty of water to drink.

Children will need to wear their normal school uniform and have a rain-proof coat and/or suncream and sunhat, depending on the weather on the day.

If you would be able to support the trip as a parent volunteer, please let your child's class teacher know.
