What is the purpose of this trip? | Missions

What is the Mission Project your Group will be participating in? | NorthStar is partnering with Josiah Venture to conduct an English language Summer Camp for Slovak middle school students. Our team will be paired with a local Slovak church team and a Josiah Venture Missionary. Josiah Venture Vision statement: <https://www.josiahventure.com/abo>

Cost: (*Land only...you will purchase your own airfare, flight info tbd*)

- \$900 +airfare (current airfare price between \$1400 and \$1500)
- \$100 deposit is due by February 20, and all final payments are due by June 1

What does the cost include? | most meals, housing, ground transportation, the supplies for the mission project, and a team t-shirt

What does the cost NOT include? | Plane ticket, checked bag fees, money for snacks and souvenirs, and travel meals coming and going

What additional considerations are there?

- This is a great first mission trip...or a valuable experience for a seasoned missionary...and everything in between.
- Immunizations based on physician recommendation
- Passport must not expire until after Jan12, 2028 (Government requires 6 additional months after the return flight before passport expires)
- There are currently no vaccine requirements or COVID testing requirements in place for this trip. If that changes, those costs would need to be covered by the participant.
