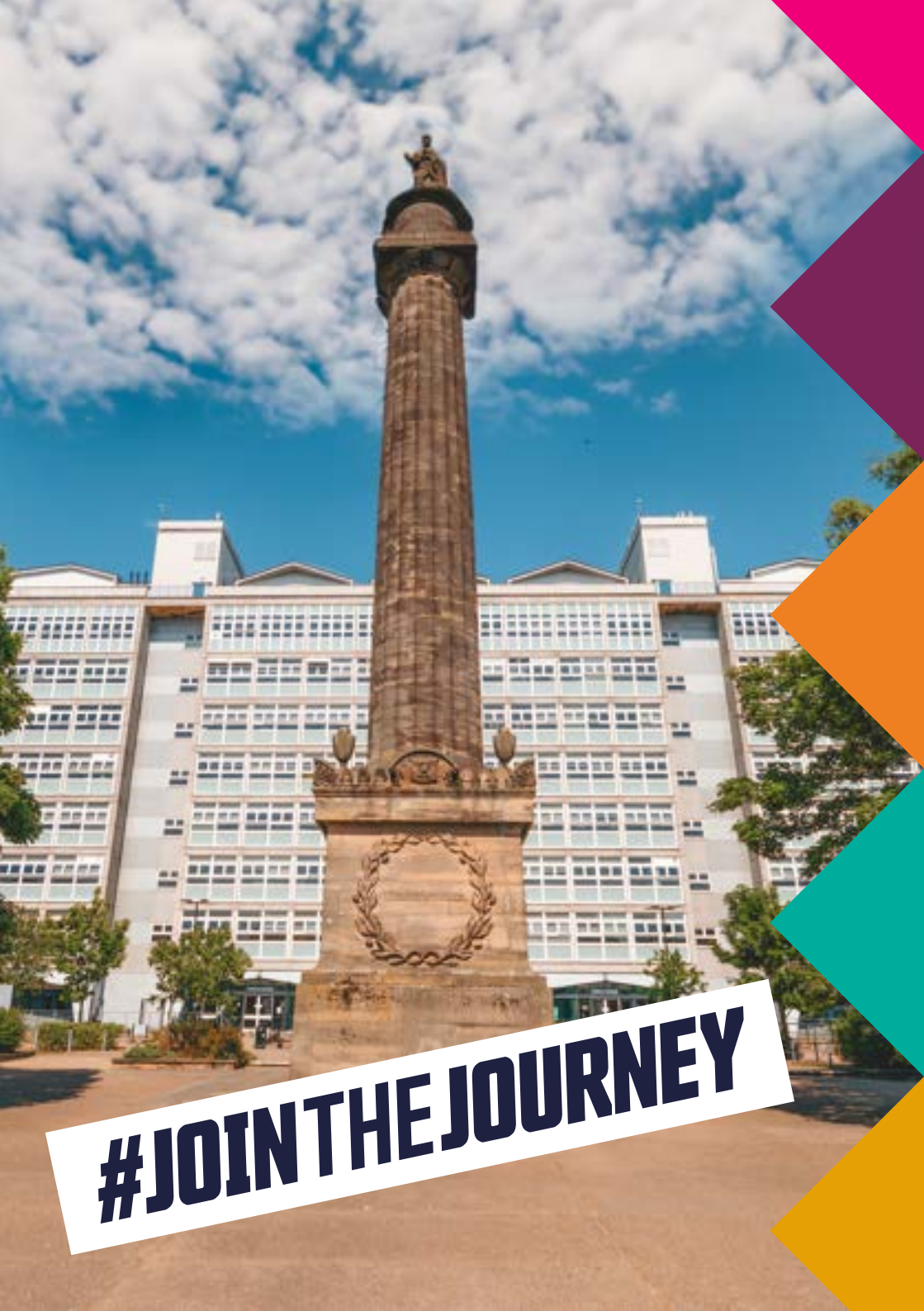

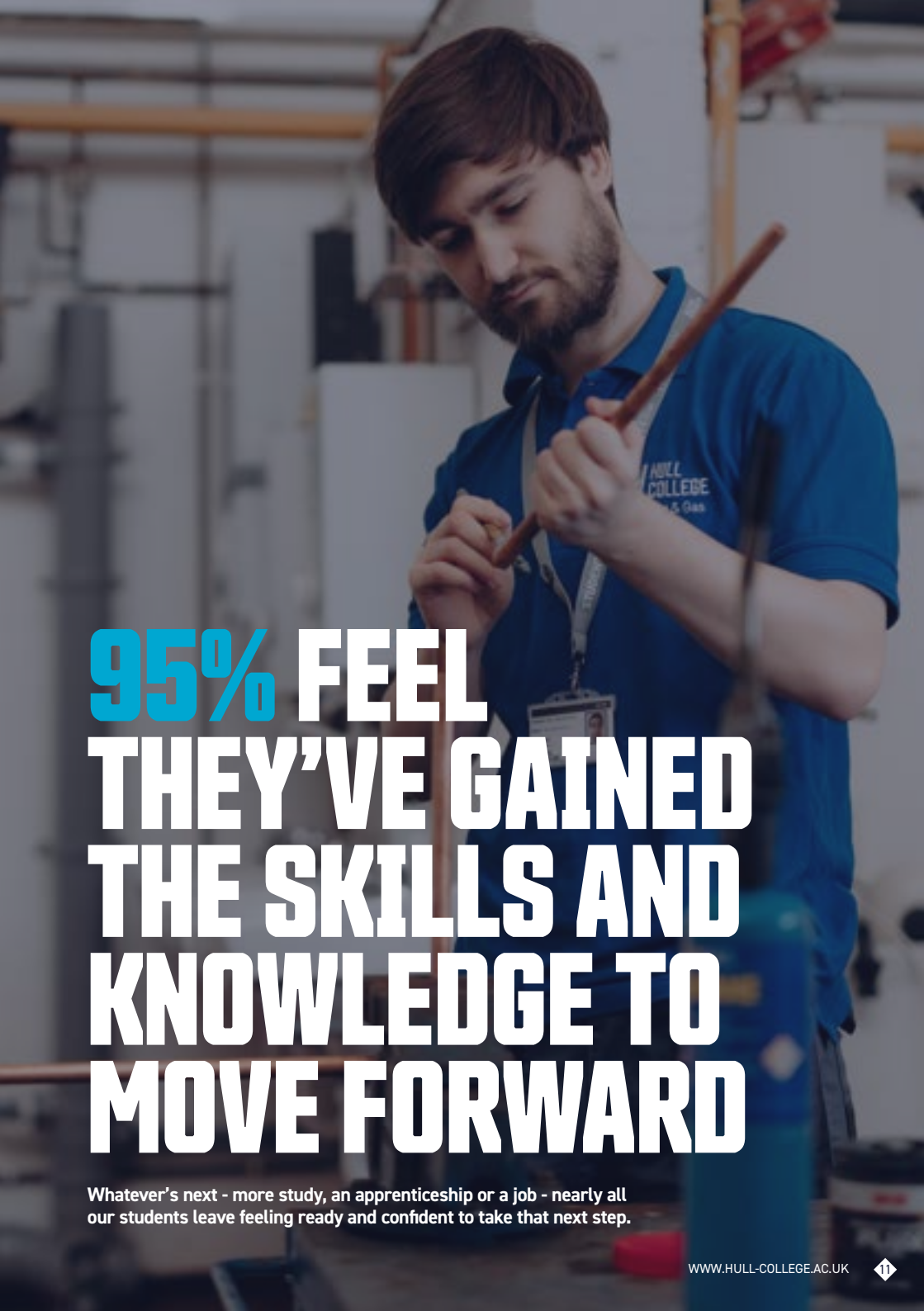

COURSE: CULINARY ARTS

Former Kelvin Hall student Izzy is studying Advanced Culinary Arts at Hull College after completing her level 2 qualification last year. Passionate about cooking since her GCSEs, she's already making her mark in the kitchen - representing the college in national competitions and gaining invaluable real-world experience through placements and events.

Why did you choose to study Culinary Arts at Hull College?

It was one of my strongest subjects at school and something I really enjoyed. When I saw that Hull College offered a course in it, it just opened the door for me even more. I knew I wanted to do it.

What's your favourite part about your course?

Meeting new people and getting involved in experiences you wouldn't get on a normal day. Everyone on the course has the same interests and goals, so it's really fun learning together and pushing each other to improve.

Zach, a former Acton Academy student, chose Hull College to pursue his passion for fashion. With years of hands-on experience at a local tailor before enrolling, Zach wanted to focus solely on his creative ambitions - and Hull College gave him the perfect opportunity to do just that.

Why did you choose to study Fashion at Hull College?

I've always been passionate about fashion and loved the idea of being able to focus entirely on one subject - that was a huge factor for me. I didn't want to study three or four subjects like at sixth form. I just wanted to do fashion, and Hull College let me do exactly that.

What's your favourite part about your course?

The people - both students and staff. It's been amazing to share the studio with others who have the same interests and ambitions. And seeing your designs come to life from a sketch to a finished garment - it's one of the most satisfying and fulfilling things ever!

How has your time at Hull College helped you?

It's helped me grow in confidence more than anything. When I started, I wasn't as outgoing, but now I'm talking to new people all the time - even within the industry through our work experience projects. The support from the tutors has been amazing. Their feedback helped me develop my existing skills and build new ones too.

What's the most interesting thing you've learnt about Fashion?

I've really enjoyed learning more about design - especially pattern-cutting and adapting designs. I already had some experience from working in a tailor shop, but the course has expanded my skills so much. I've also loved the work experience projects, which helped shape my own style and aesthetic.

Any advice for anyone considering the course?

Absolutely go for it - especially if fashion is your passion like it was for me. You'll study everything from pattern-cutting and prints to fabric manipulation. The range of skills you learn is incredible, and there are so many exciting opportunities afterwards. Plus, the tutors are fantastic and genuinely care about helping you succeed.

Next steps:

Zach secured a place at the London College of Fashion to study Menswear Design - an achievement he describes as "the best thing that's ever happened to me." He credits Hull College for giving him the belief, skills, and support needed to take the next big step in his fashion journey.

THOMAS

COURSE: HEALTH & SOCIAL CARE

Former Wolfreton School and Sixth Form student Thomas joined Hull College after initially studying photography. Now 18, he's completed the first year of his Health and Social Care course and is fully focused on pursuing his dream career as a paramedic.

Why did you choose to study Health and Social Care at Hull College?

I've always had an interest in becoming a paramedic, and when I spotted the Health and Social Care course, I knew it was the right fit. I wanted something more than just a hobby - something with a real career path. This course felt right from the start and has helped me focus on my future.

What's your favourite part or best thing about your course?

The people I've met and the experiences I've had. The course is genuinely interesting from day one and it feels like everything we're learning is preparing us for real careers. It's more than just classroom learning - it's hands-on and meaningful.

How has your time been as a student at the college?

It's been great. The tutors - Sarah, Noelle, and Diane - are incredible. The facilities, like the clinical skills rooms and mock ambulance, make learning so much more realistic. Even using mannequins like 'Big Bertha' gives you a feel for real-life situations. Plus, the group atmosphere is brilliant - we all work well together and support each other.

How has your time at Hull College helped you?

My communication skills have improved massively. I'm now confident speaking one-on-one and in group settings. The course has helped me develop skills that are essential for working in healthcare, like first aid, safeguarding, and even stroke awareness. It's also helped me feel more prepared for what's next - both in education and my future career.

What's the most interesting thing you've learnt about Health and Social Care?

I'd say safeguarding. Even though it's a heavy topic, it's so important and surprisingly interesting. It opened my eyes to just how vital these responsibilities are in the health sector.

Any advice for anyone considering the course?

Go for it! You'll learn so much more than you expect - not just about health and social care, but about yourself. You don't just get a qualification; you get practical skills that are useful in everyday life. If you're willing to put in the effort, you'll get so much back.

After starting her journey at 14+ College, Katie progressed seamlessly into our Level 3 Art & Design course, specialising in Illustration. Her time here gave her the freedom to focus on one creative path, build her confidence, and prepare for the next stage of her journey - studying Creative Writing at York St John University.

Why did you choose to study Art & Design (Illustration) at Hull College?

I wanted a break from traditional academics after GCSEs. I wanted to do something I really enjoyed - something creative where I could focus on one subject. I liked that I could explore different pathways before specialising, and I knew I could be myself here.

What's your favourite part or best thing about your course?

The freedom. You're trusted to work independently but always supported. I loved being able to focus all my energy on one subject I'm passionate about. The atmosphere is great, the studios are well-equipped, and our illustration tutor, Laura, is one of the loveliest and most supportive people. Everyone in the class was different, but we all shared the same creative drive - and that made it special.

How has your time been as a student at the college?

It's been brilliant. You get your own space, access to fantastic equipment, and the freedom to explore different areas. I've developed so much confidence, not just in my work but in myself. Two years ago, I wouldn't have accepted a compliment - now I take pride in what I do. The creative environment really helped me understand who I am and gave me space to grow both artistically and personally.

How has your time at Hull College helped you?

It's helped me realise that I can pursue a creative career and believe in my abilities. My time here also helped me secure a place at university - I'm now going on to study Creative Writing at York St John.

What's the most interesting thing you've learnt about Illustration?

How much creative freedom there is. Even within Illustration, we had the chance to dip into other areas - like fashion, printmaking, and fine art - and bring those influences into our own work. I realised there's no single 'right way' to be an illustrator.

Any advice for anyone considering the course?

If you're creative but not sure what direction to go in, this course gives you time and space to figure that out. You'll discover more about who you are, what you enjoy, and where you might want to go next.

COURSE: **ESPORTS**

Reece joined Hull College with a clear vision - to explore the rapidly growing Esports industry and build the skills needed to one day launch his own business. Over his two-year course, he grew in confidence, developed industry-relevant skills, and gained invaluable hands-on experience in everything from video production to event management.

Why did you choose to study Esports at Hull College?

I was really drawn to the Esports industry - it's such a fast-growing and exciting space with loads of different roles and opportunities. I've always had ambitions to start my own business, and this course helps me learn how to build a brand, price products, market them effectively, and even design a website.

What's your favourite part or best thing about your course?

The range of things we cover. It's not just about gaming - we've learned video production, social media management, fitness and nutrition, computer networking, and even how to plan and run live events. I've had the chance to host events at the Federation of Sport and even ran a VR experience for staff on a CPD day, which was amazing.

How has your time been as a student at the college?

It's been brilliant. I've developed loads of personal skills, especially confidence. I used to be really shy, but now I'm much more comfortable talking to people and presenting. I also worked part-time outside of college and feel much more prepared for the world of work.

How has your time at Hull College helped you?

Studying Esports here has opened so many doors. I've learned how to manage my time, take responsibility, and make the most of the freedom we have as students. Having that independence has helped me grow massively - both personally and professionally.

What's the most interesting thing you've learnt about Esports?

How much more there is to it beyond just playing games. From fitness routines and BMI testing to setting up a server network and producing marketing videos, it's a much broader industry than people think. It's given me a full picture of what it takes to succeed in Esports - both on and off the screen.

Any advice for anyone considering the course?

You have to be fully committed. There's a lot to learn, so managing your time is key. But if you put in the effort, the rewards are huge - you'll come away with real skills, confidence, and a clear path.

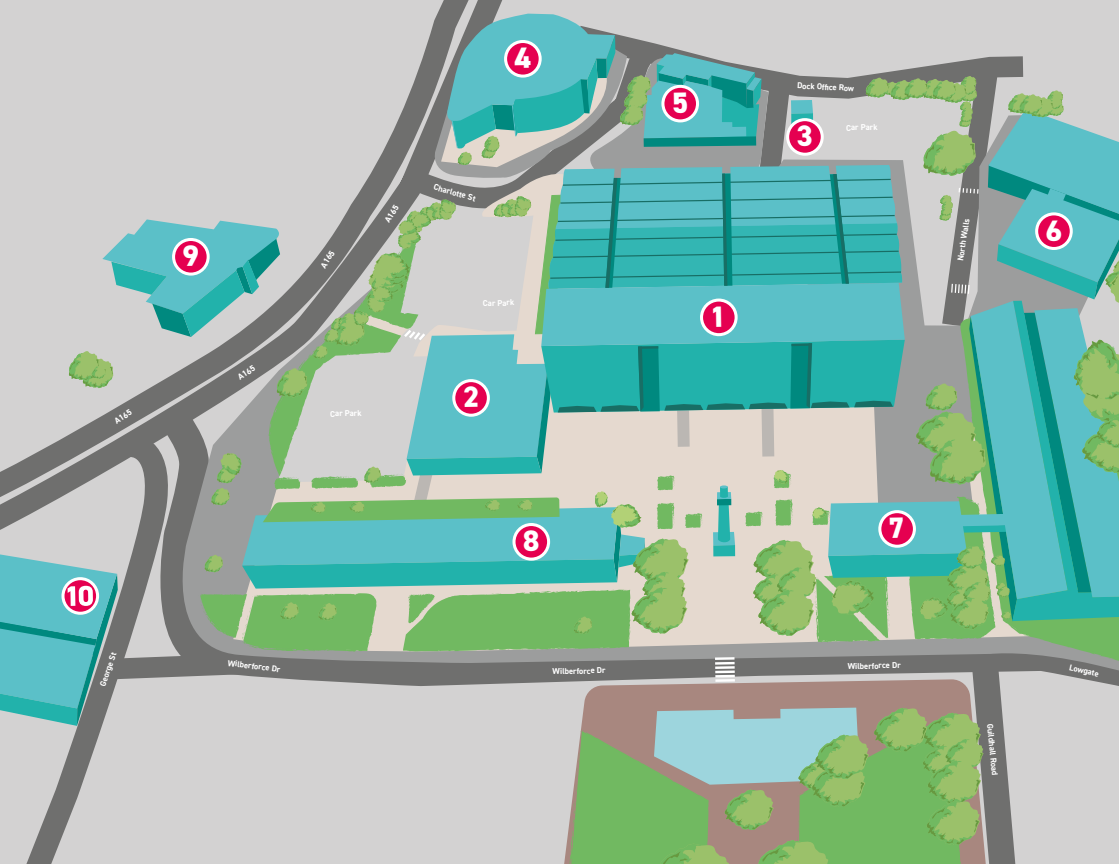
UNIQUE CAMPUS

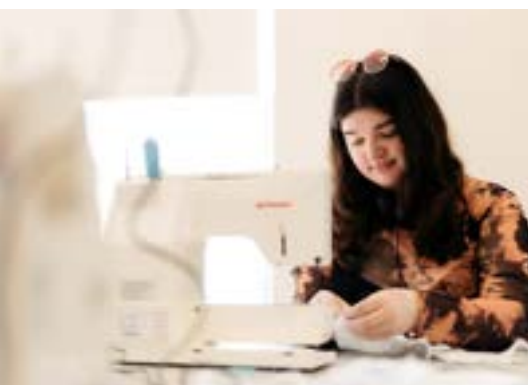

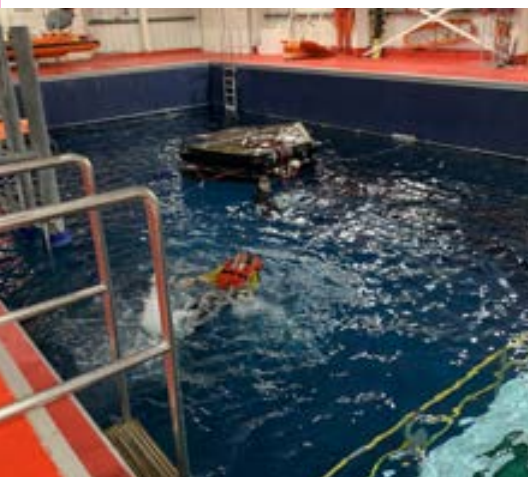

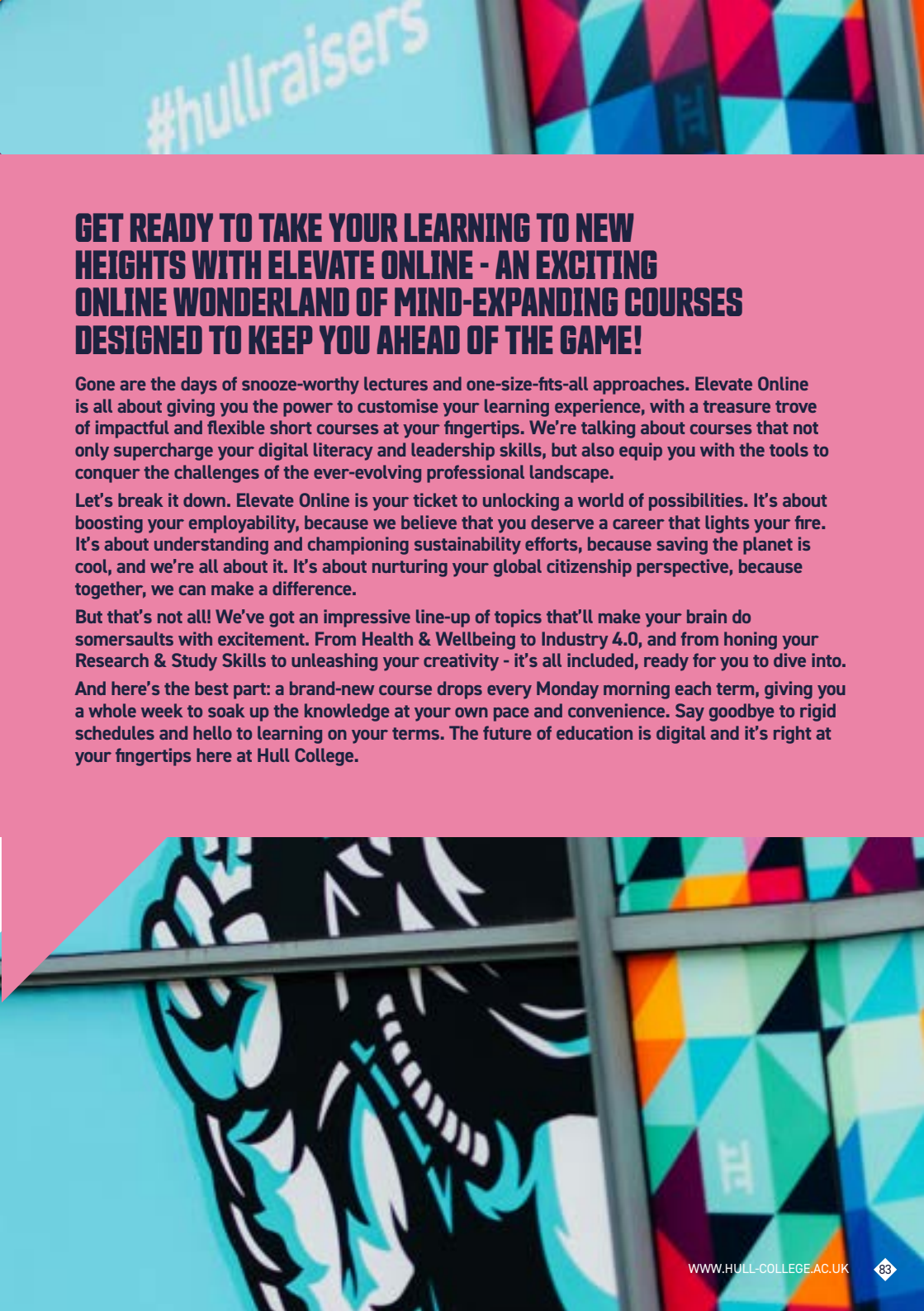
