

- Fall Semester** ● Review Applications
- Spring Semester** ● Check applicant's college attendance and rugby participation. Award scholarship.

About the Scholarship



Paul Horne

Paul is a proud alumnus and former player of Western Washington University, where his passion for rugby began. He has enjoyed an extensive coaching career, including positions with teams in British Columbia and the Canadian National Men's team. In recognition of his contributions to the sport, Paul was inducted into the British Columbia Rugby Hall of Fame in 2015. Today, he serves as the Director of Rugby at Western Washington University, continuing to mentor and develop the next generation of rugby talent.

The Scholarship

The Paul Horne Scholarship supports elite student-athletes pursuing rugby at Western Washington University. One international or out-of-state student with a strong rugby background is awarded \$5,000 annually, distributed evenly across the Fall, Winter, and Spring quarters. The scholarship is reviewed each quarter and is contingent on maintaining strong academic performance and high-level athletic contribution on the field. Applicants must submit a letter of application to the Western Rugby Alumni (WRA), with applications completed in the Spring prior to Fall enrollment. This scholarship aims to recognize and support exceptional rugby talent while encouraging academic and athletic excellence.
