The Scholarship


The Kaler Family Scholarships support graduating high school rugby players pursuing higher education. Each year, the US Rugby Foundation awards one scholarship to a deserving male and one to a deserving female athlete. Each scholarship is valued at \$1,500.

The scholarship is intended for students who have been active in their high school rugby programs and plan to continue their education at an accredited college or university. Funds may be used toward tuition, books, or fees.

The Kaler Family

The Kaler Family Rugby Scholarship was founded in 2016 by Paul and Sarah Kaler, whose lives have been deeply shaped by the rugby community. Paul began his rugby career in 1990 with River City RFC (Mason City, IA), later playing for the Eastside Banshees (Minneapolis, MN), Wausau Area Rugby (Wausau, WI), and now the St. Louis Royal Ramblers. Sarah started playing in 1996 at Wartburg University (Waverly, IA) and went on to play club rugby with Wausau Area Rugby Women.

Both Paul and Sarah are passionate rugby tourists, traveling nationwide to support their children and across the globe to compete at various levels. Their dedication to youth and amateur rugby has inspired them to fund scholarships through private donors and personal contributions as a way to give back to a sport they love.
