Written comments of Moorsbus passengers

Passengers were invited to fill in self-completion questionnaires which were available on every bus on every operational day in 2025. In addition an online survey was available, accessed through a QR code on buses and on the website. The surveys represent 818 passengers in 489 groups, although only just half of them added a written comment.

These comments are transcribed verbatim from survey forms. Full postcode zone data was collected but has been abridged to Postcode district data to ensure anonymity. Results from the past ten years, together with an analysis of the full survey data, are available on the **moorsbus.org** website.

At present I am donating when I use the bus each time and having spoken to other users there seem to be a lot of other people unaware that this option is available. A direct bus to Thornton le Dale would be lovely as previous services meant us having to leave at 3.30pm to get home via Pickering and the M3. Very frustrating visit today. I drove to Pickering from Hull and intended to take the bus to Danby, spend an hour there and get the later bus back to Pickering. However, the 14:45 service from Pickering to Danby broke down almost instantly which is hardly surprising given how unreliable East Yorkshire has become lately. As a result I had to get the next bus (15:45 from Pickering) which meant I just went to Danby and straight back as there wasn't a later bus back to Pickering. All in all, a pretty wasted trip. As an aside I live in Hull and am pleased to see the 'feeder' bus from Hull back as part of the network. However, I have not used it once as I don't trust East Yorkshire to get me there and back on time; I have seen numerous EY buses break down this year, especially on the Hull-York route, and have been delayed/stuck on a number of occasions. As a result when I have used Moorsbus this year, I've continued to drive to Pickering from Hull. September finish. October too dark. HU16 The breakdowns were obviously disappointing, especially as it was the last day and I had been planning to

nip to two shops in Pickering during the 2 short stops morning and evening, neither of which happened. At least we all managed to spend a final day in the countryside - the main purpose of the trip. However, it is reassuring to have the hep of the Moorsbus organisers in these circumstances. It was good that someone contacted the Ryedale Folk Museum to let them know the M3 had broken down at Castleton so they could come out and let us know. Luckily there were 3 of us waiting so someone was able to pop into the museum to ask them to contact you, but if I had been alone I wouldn't have dared leave the bus stop in case the bus sailed past! Happy with the way the problem was resolved thanks for the lift to Pickering, Eden.
- M1 Moorsbus broke down on the way to Pickering from Hull. The 12:45 M6 waited until the M1 arrived in Pickering. The 15:43 M3 from Danby broke down on the moors soon after we left Castleton. The driver Sharon had to get us out of the bus because there was black smoke coming from the engine. She and another passenger had to direct traffic because the bus was blocking the lane going towards the Lion Inn. The M6 collected the passengers and detoured to the Lion Inn to drop off / collect passengers. The Hull / Beverley passengers waited in Pickering until the M6 returned. Ryan the driver of the M6 went out of his way to help passengers. Sharon the driver of the M3/M1 was stranded on the moors with another passenger (who volunteered to stay with her) until East Yorkshire sent a recovery vehicle for he and the bus. I missed the EY128 at 17:15 from Pickering so had to wait until 19:15 for the next EY128 to Scarborough. I hope that Sharon and the remaining got home in Hull all right.
