

Moorsbus Network FAQs - staff/volunteer notes - updated March 2026

- The Moorsbus Network operates on Saturdays, Sundays and Public Holidays, from the beginning of April to the end of September.
- Some people need help to find the information that they need. You can find the answers to most questions on [Moorsbus.org](https://www.moorsbus.org), and also in our paper Moorsbus Network booklets.
- We also produce some “Days Out from...” guides from several towns. These are printable from our website <https://www.moorsbus.org/days-out>. If you have difficulty printing things, let us know and we’ll print some for you.
- The Sunday and Public Holiday timetables are identical. Some routes don’t operate on Saturdays, or do so at different times. This is due to funding, and because of connections with commercial weekday services outside The Park.
- Routes are colour-coded on the map (reverse of booklet) & pages,
- Dogs travel free on Moorsbus services
- Moorsbus services use marked stops in town areas. In rural areas they will stop anywhere it is safe to do so, but passengers should give clear signal to the driver, and as much advance warning as possible.
- To find the exact location of any Moorsbus (and any other bus in the UK) the **bustimes.org** website is really helpful. It shows expected times along the route, all the timetables, the type and livery of the bus, and how full it is.
- Moorsbus services have wheelchair ramps, but some bus stops have no kerb, which makes for a steep ramp, boarding and alighting
- The Moorsbus Network is organised by volunteers who are Moorsbus Community Interest Company, supported by Friends of Moorsbus, a small unregistered Charity.
- Moorsbus CIC contract with commercial bus companies. The buses are funded by a combination of fares, local authority grants, passenger donations and fundraising efforts. Donations can be made [moorsbus.org](https://www.moorsbus.org), or via the bus drivers, who will issue a “Donate ticket- not valid for travel”.
