- The main objective of this study was to investigate and understand the main environmental challenges during beer production through literature review, life cycle assessment, and small-scale home brewing experiments for the gathering of quantitative data and empirical learning.
- Quantitative data from LCAs found in the literature were compared to a selfexecuted homebrewing LCA which validated that the main environmental impacts come from the water and energy demand, and by-products.
- It was found that a 60% reduction in water demand could be accomplished by eliminating the cooling step during the beer production; energy efficiencies could be achieved by adding a hydrodynamic cavitation reactor.
- The upcycling of wet spent grain into flour showed a comprehensive solution with environmental benefits and business opportunities.
