 One of Margaux's oldest estates, crafting a wine known for its floral perfume, silky tannins, and graceful aging potential
 - Le Petit Smith Haut Lafitte Pessac-Léognan, Bordeaux, France, 2019
 A second wine from Smith Haut Lafitte, showcasing the estate's signature smoky minerality and deep black fruit
- Chateau de Ferrand Saint Emilion, Bordeaux, France, 2016
 A Saint-Émilion standout, offering a perfect balance of Merlot's plush fruit and the limestone terroir's freshness
- Louis Jadot Pommard, Burgundy, France, 2018
 A historic Burgundy house since 1859, it is known for its terroir-driven wines like Pommard, an appellation famed for producing some of the Côte de Beaune's most powerful and age-worthy Pinot Noirs, once favored by Napoleon himself

1100/450	Marchese Antinori Tignanello, Tuscany, Italy, 2021 The first modern red wine in Tuscany to blend non-traditional grapes like Cabernet Sauvignon, making it a pioneer of the Super Tuscan movement
620/2450	Tommasi Amarone Classico Della Valpolicella, Veneto, Italy, 2018 Made using the traditional "appassimento" method, where grapes are dried for about 100 days, concentrating their flavors and creating its signature rich, velvety taste
250/950	Catena Malbec, Argentina, 2021 From Argentina's pioneering Malbec producer, this wine is unique for its altitude-driven freshness, combining power with elegance
290/1200	Decoy Zinfandel, Sonoma County, USA, 2021 The "Decoy" name was originally meant to be a second label but became so popular that it turned into a brand of its own
490/1990	Duckhorn Merlot, Napa Valley, USA, 2021 Duckhorn Merlot gained fame after being featured in the 2004 movie Sideways, despite the film's anti-Merlot stance, which ironically boosted its popularity

 From the vineyard that won the Judgment of Paris, this Cabernet is known for its silky tannins, deep black fruit, and elegant structure
- Robert Mondavi Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa, USA, 2021 720/2880 Robert Mondavi, a pioneering figure in California winemaking, is celebrated for revolutionizing the Napa Valley wine industry
 - Catena Cabernet Sauvignon, Argentina, 2021 410/1650 comes from some of the highest-altitude vineyards in Mendoza, where the Catena family, pioneers of high-altitude viticulture in Argentina, proved that world-class Cabernet
