Known for producing bubbles, enjoyed even at VIP events like the Cannes Film Festival

Chandon Brut, Australia, NV

1200

Crafted by Moët & Chandon's Australian outpost, one of the first places outside France where the Champagne House expanded its sparkling wine expertise

Chandon Brut Rosé, Australia, NV

1300

Crafted by Moët & Chandon's Australian winery, blending French tradition with Aussie innovation

Bellavista Alma Gran Cuvee Franciacorta Brut, Italy, NV

1790

The name "Alma" means "soul" in Latin, symbolizing the heart and spirit of Bellavista's winemaking philosophy

RICH & POWERFUL CHAMPAGNES

Duval Leroy Brut Reserve, Champagne, France, NV

1920

The first Champagne to be crafted by a female head winemaker, Sandrine Logette-Jardin, in a historically male-dominated industry

Louis Roederer Brut Premier, Champagne, France, NV

2400

Official Champagne of the Oscars for over a decade, adding Hollywood sparkle to its already prestigious reputation

Veuve Clicquot Brut, Champagne, France, NV

2800

Created by Madame Clicquot, who invented the riddling process, a game-changing technique that made Champagne clearer and more refined

Moët & Chandon Imperial, Champagne, France, NV

2890

Created as a richer, more intense version of the classic Moët Impérial, designed to pair perfectly with gourmet cuisine

Pol Roger Brut, Champagne, France, NV

2220

Both the Champagne of choice for Winston Churchill, who famously consumed over 42,000 bottles, and a royal favorite, served at Prince William and Kate Middleton's wedding, hold a Royal Warrant as an official supplier to the British Royal Family

Henriot Brut Souverain, Champagne, France, NV

2390

Favored by European royalty and received a Royal Warrant from Emperor Franz Joseph I of Austria. Known for its elegant blend of 29 crus, it remains a symbol of refined, aristocratic Champagne

Henriot Brut Rose, Champagne, France, NV Crafted with a high proportion of Chardonnay, making it one of the rare rosé Champagnes known for its elegance, freshness, and luminous minerality	2950
Perrier-Jouët Blason Rose, Champagne, France, NV The first rosé Champagne ever created by the house, inspired by the rich, gourmet flavors of fine cuisine	7250

Krug Grande Cuvée Edition 170th, Champagne, France, NV Crafted from a blend of over 120 reserve wines spanning more than 10 different vintages, making it one of the most complex and multi-layered Champagnes in the world	12490

Babich Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2023 Babich is New Zealand's oldest family-owned winery, founded in 1916, and still run by the Babich family today	245/990
Deetlefs 'Stonecross' Chenin Blanc, South Africa, 2023 The Private Label Manufacturers Association in Europe awarded the "Best New World White Wine" in 2019	210/810
Modello Masi Pinot Grigio, Italy, 2021 Masi, famous for pioneering the "appassimento" drying technique used in Amarone wines	245/990
Antinori Guado al Tasso Vermentino, Tuscany, Italy, 2023 Bolgheri region is famously called the "Bolgheri amphitheater" due to its unique coastal microclimate that enhances the wine's freshness and minerality	230/890

Simonnet-Febvre Chablis 1er Cru, Burgundy, France, 2020 A historic Chablis house known for its precise and mineral-driven style	480/1910
Domaine Vacheron Sancerre, France, 2022 A biodynamic, family-run estate that embodies Sancerre's excellence	400/1600
Hugel Gewurztraminer, Alsace, France, 2018 A family-run winery since 1639, helped popularize Gewürztraminer worldwide, making it one of Alsace's most iconic aromatic wines	290/1165
Trimbach Pinot Gris Réserve, Alsace, France, 2018 Trimbach Pinot Gris Réserve comes from a winery founded in 1626, making it older than the United States	320/1250
Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand, 2023 Put New Zealand on the world wine map in the 1980s, often described as "sunshine in a glass."	450/1790

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INTENSE & COMPLEX WHITES

- Domaine du Closel La Jalousie Savennières, Loire Valley, France, 2021** 390/1550
One of the few female-led estates in the Loire Valley, with a winemaking history deeply tied to noble French women since the 19th century
- Diel Dorsheimer Goldloch Riesling, Germany, 2009** 555/2220
"Goldloch," translates to "gold hole," a nod to old legends of hidden treasure and the site's prized, mineral-rich soils
- Louis Latour Mâcon-Village, Burgundy, France, 2022** 290/1150
One of Burgundy's most historic wineries has been family-run for over 230 years and is famous for mastering both Chardonnay across generations
- Louis Latour Meursault, Burgundy, France, 2020** 990/3990
Known for crafting rich, age-worthy Meursault wines that beautifully express the region's famed terroir
- Eric Guigal Condrieu, Rhône Valley, France, 2020** 580/2300
Made from 100% Viognier, a grape so fragrant and rich that legend says it was once reserved for the tables of Roman emperors
- Eric Guigal Crozes-Hermitage, Rhône Valley, France, 2018** 320/1270
Ages their Crozes-Hermitage in oak barrels for added complexity, despite the appellation traditionally favoring stainless steel
- Eric Guigal Châteauneuf-du-Pâpe, Rhône Valley, France, 2018** 425/1700
Less than 10% of Châteauneuf-du-Pape production is dedicated to white wine, making it a hidden treasure of the Rhône Valley
- Eric Guigal Hermitage, Rhône Valley, France, 2018** 480/1925
Known for elevating Rhône wines to global fame, crafts his Hermitage with exceptional depth, continuing his family's legacy of perfection since 1946
- Stag's Leap Wine Cellars Karia Chardonnay, Napa Valley, USA, 2022** 380/1550
Karia gets its name from the Greek word kharis, meaning grace and beauty, perfectly reflecting its elegant and refined style
- Robert Mondavi Chardonnay, Napa Valley, USA, 2018** 535/2145
Reflects the legacy of a man who once teamed up with Baron Philippe de Rothschild to create Opus One, one of Napa Valley's most iconic wines

FRESH & DELICATE ROSES

- Minuty M, Provence, France, 2022** 295/1240
An icon of Provence rosé, crafted by the Matton family for generations. A go-to rosé for beachside sipping and summer vibes
- Whispering Angel, Provence, France, 2023** 295/1240
The world-famous Provence rosé is so popular that it's been dubbed the "Hamptons Water" due to its massive following among summer beachgoers
- Eric Guigal Tavel, Rhone Valley, France, 2022** 295/1240
This AOC is dedicated exclusively to rosé, and legend has it that it was a favorite of both Louis XIV and Ernest Hemingway
- Miraval, Provence, France, 2023** 340/1360
Famously owned by Hollywood stars Brad Pitt and Angelina Jolie, making it one of the most glamorous rosés in the world

Louis Latour Fleurie, Cru Beaujolais, France 2021	320/1270
A wine from the "Queen of Beaujolais" appellation, famous for its floral aromas and silky texture	
Louis Jadot Echézeaux Grand Cru, Burgundy, 2015	7500
Sourced from one of Burgundy's finest Grand Crus, where monks first cultivated vines over a thousand years ago	
Gaja Barbaresco, Piedmont, Italy 2014	6400
Angelo Gaja's Barbaresco redefined the appellation, offering unparalleled depth, purity of fruit, and a long, perfumed finish	
Alfredo Prunotto Barbaresco, Piedmont, Italy 2020	445/1790
A visionary producer who rescued a struggling cooperative winery in the 1920s, turning it into one of Piedmont's most respected producers	
Alta Mora Etna Rosso, Sicily, Italy, 2020	275/1100
Grown on the slopes of Mount Etna, Europe's most active volcano, giving the wine a unique mineral character from volcanic soils	
Robert Mondavi Pinot Noir, Napa, 2021	290/1145
Napa's warmth gives this Pinot extra ripeness, balancing California richness with Burgundian elegance	

CLASSIC & TIMELESS REDS

Banfi Chianti Classico, Tuscany, Italy, 2021	305/1220
A winery famous for pioneering Sangiovese clones, helping to elevate Tuscan wines to world-class status	
Gaja Ca' Marcanda Promis IGT, Tuscany, Italy, 2021	450/1790
"Ca' Marcanda" means "house of endless negotiations" in the Piedmontese dialect, referring to the long bargaining process Angelo Gaja went through to acquire the Bolgheri estate	
Chateau Paveil de Luze Margaux, Bordeaux, France, 2014	750/3040
One of Margaux's oldest estates, crafting a wine known for its floral perfume, silky tannins, and graceful aging potential	
Le Petit Smith Haut Lafitte Pessac-Léognan, Bordeaux, France, 2019	600/2390
A second wine from Smith Haut Lafitte, showcasing the estate's signature smoky minerality and deep black fruit	
Chateau de Ferrand Saint Emilion, Bordeaux, France, 2016	690/2780
A Saint-Émilion standout, offering a perfect balance of Merlot's plush fruit and the limestone terroir's freshness	
Louis Jadot Pommard, Burgundy, France, 2018	590/2350
A historic Burgundy house since 1859, it is known for its terroir-driven wines like Pommard, an appellation famed for producing some of the Côte de Beaune's most powerful and age-worthy Pinot Noirs, once favored by Napoleon himself

De la Fleur de Bouard Pomerol, France, 2015	535/2140
A standout Pomerol, distinguished by its lush Merlot core, opulent texture, and truffle-scented finish	
Château Troplong Mondot Saint-Emilion, Bordeaux, France, 2014	6600
A prestigious Saint-Emilion estate produced a remarkable 2015 vintage that is celebrated for its opulent fruit, silky tannins	
Domaine des Sénéchaux Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Rhône Valley, France, 2020	450/1800
One of the oldest vineyards in Châteauneuf-du-Pape, dates back to the 14th century and was once tended by the papal clergy	
Marqués de Murrieta Rioja Reserva, Spain, 2018	435/1735
Harmony of Tempranillo grapes aged for 18 months in American oak barrels, resulting in a rich and complex flavor profile	
Banfi Brunello di Montalcino, Tuscany, Italy, 2018	625/2500
The first winery in Montalcino to introduce clonal research on Sangiovese, revolutionizing Brunello production for greater quality and consistency	
Alfredo Prunotto Barolo Bussia, Piedmont, Italy, 2012	625/2500
Alfredo Prunotto was a pioneer in exporting Piedmont wines globally, and his Barolo Bussia perfectly balances power and elegance	
Marchese Antinori Tignanello, Tuscany, Italy, 2021	1100/4500
The first modern red wine in Tuscany to blend non-traditional grapes like Cabernet Sauvignon, making it a pioneer of the Super Tuscan movement	
Tommasi Amarone Classico Della Valpolicella, Veneto, Italy, 2018	620/2450
Made using the traditional "appassimento" method, where grapes are dried for about 100 days, concentrating their flavors and creating its signature rich, velvety taste	
Catena Malbec, Argentina, 2021	250/950
From Argentina's pioneering Malbec producer, this wine is unique for its altitude-driven freshness, combining power with elegance	
Decoy Zinfandel, Sonoma County, USA, 2021	290/1200
The "Decoy" name was originally meant to be a second label but became so popular that it turned into a brand of its own	
Duckhorn Merlot, Napa Valley, USA, 2021	490/1990
Duckhorn Merlot gained fame after being featured in the 2004 movie Sideways, despite the film's anti-Merlot stance, which ironically boosted its popularity

Pauillac de Château Latour, Bordeaux, France, 2015	4300
While it's the third wine of the legendary Château Latour, Pauillac de Latour is crafted with the same care, vineyard precision, and cellar expertise as its prestigious siblings	
Château Lynch Bages Pauillac, Bordeaux, 2015	8600
Known for producing exceptional wines, the 2008 vintage hailed for its balance and aging potential, making it a favorite among collectors	
Vega-Sicilia Valbuena 5°, Ribera del Duero, Spain, 2013	6300
Spain's most legendary estate crafts this wine with meticulous aging, creating a deep, complex expression of Tempranillo with layers of spice and earth	
Mollydooker The Maitre D, McLaren Valley, Australia, 2021	340/1360
A bold and fruit-forward wine, known for its "shake to awaken" technique that enhances the wine's flavors by mixing in nitrogen before serving	
Stag's Leap Wine Cellars Fay, Cabernet Sauvignon, USA, 2006	6100
From the vineyard that won the Judgment of Paris, this Cabernet is known for its silky tannins, deep black fruit, and elegant structure	
Robert Mondavi Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa, USA, 2021	720/2880
Robert Mondavi, a pioneering figure in California winemaking, is celebrated for revolutionizing the Napa Valley wine industry	
Catena Cabernet Sauvignon, Argentina, 2021	410/1650
comes from some of the highest-altitude vineyards in Mendoza, where the Catena family, pioneers of high-altitude viticulture in Argentina, proved that world-class Cabernet	

SPICY & INTENSE REDS

Penfolds Bin 28 Shiraz, Barossa Valley, Australia, 2022	275/1095
Crafted from grapes sourced from some of Australia's finest vineyards, highlighting the winery's iconic status in the world of wine	
Two-Hand Waterfall Block Shiraz, Adelaide Hills, Australia, 2020	495/1990
Reflecting the unique terroir of the Barossa Valley, where the grapes are meticulously handpicked from a single vineyard block renowned for its exceptional quality	
Torbreck Woodcutter's Shiraz, Barossa Valley, Australia, 2022	320/1250
Named after founder David Powell's time as a Scottish woodcutter, and, despite its entry-level status, it delivers bold Barossa character often compared to top Rhône Syrahs	
Château de Beaucastel Châteauneuf-du-Pape, France, 2020	7500
Renowned for its unique blending of all 13 permitted grape varieties in Châteauneuf-du-Pape, showcasing the winery's commitment to complexity and harmony in every vintage, including the exceptional 2011

Château de Rolland Sauternes, France, 2020 (37.5cl) 320/1285

Resulting from the unique noble rot, Botrytis cinerea, that enhances the grapes, creating a delightful dessert wine

Dr. Loosen Riesling Ice Wine, Germany, 2018 (37.5cl) 495/1970

Crafted from grapes that are naturally frozen on the vine, producing a luscious dessert wine that beautifully balances richness and freshness

Inniskillin Gold Vidal Ice Wine, Canada, 2018 (37.5cl) 885/3850

Renowned for its luscious sweetness, crafted from grapes that are naturally frozen on the vine, making it one of the finest dessert wines in the world

W. & J. Graham's Aged 10 Years Tawny Port, Portugal 615/2475

Aged to perfection in oak casks, which allows it to develop complex aromas of dried fruits, caramel, and spices

Junmai Daiginjo 3 years snow aged, Japan 1950

A rare, meticulously aged sake, developing silky texture, deep umami, and delicate floral notes through three years of natural snow aging

Junmai Daiginjo "shinpaku" Yamada Nishiki, Japan 1395

Crafted from Japan's finest sake rice, this ultra-refined Daiginjo offers pure melon, white peach, and a smooth, elegant finish

Toyonogakura, Japan 990
