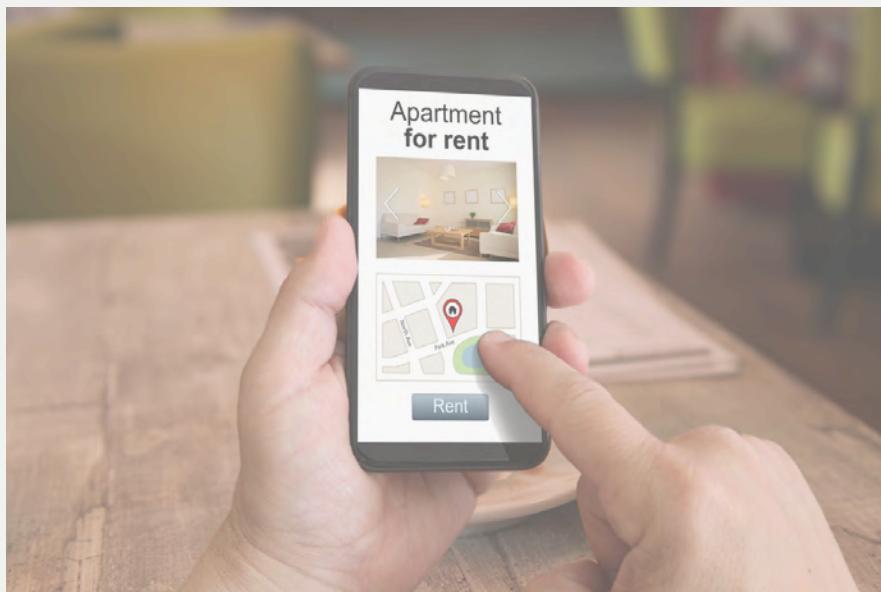

- Adhering to specific guest screening or licensing requirements.



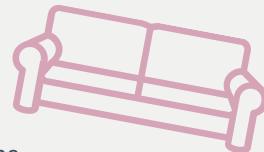
Preparing Your Property

- Include essential amenities such as a comfortable bed, seating area, and kitchen equipment.

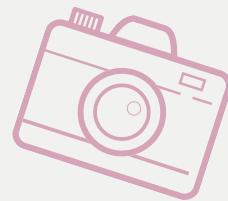


Staging for Professional Photos

Captivating photos are crucial for attracting potential guests on Airbnb. To make your property stand out, consider these staging tips:

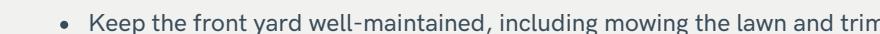


- Declutter and organize each room before taking photos.

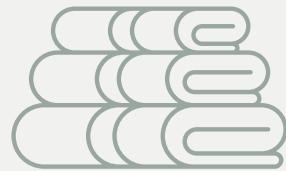

- Upload high-quality photos that showcase your property's best features. Highlight the linens in the bedroom, show off the clean bathroom. Make sure all kitchen appliances with clocks are consistent.
- Set up your availability calendar and define minimum stay requirements.
- Choose the Airbnb verification options that provide security and peace of mind for both you and your guests. Many times people will opt for a keypad lock.
- Preview and publish your listing on Airbnb. Make sure the photos are uploaded and appear the same quality on a computer, as they do on a phone.
