I'm currently studying international law in Vienna. I could not finish the school in Ukraine since **my hometown was completely bombed**, leaving my house and school in ruins. I've moved first to Germany and then to Austria for university.

ABOUT THE WAR

The war took everything that felt stable and safe-my home twice, my sense of security, and the ability to live without constantly adapting to new realities. It took away my carefree childhood, replacing it with responsibilities and worries no one should have at that age. It separated my family, scattering us across different parts of the country and beyond, making reunions rare. Some relatives I haven't seen in years, and I don't know when I will again. It took away the feeling of belonging to one place. Instead of growing up with childhood friends in a familiar neighborhood, I had to start over again and again. It took away certaintythe ability to plan ahead, to dream without the fear that everything could be shattered in an instant.

But more than anything, it took away time—time I should have spent just being a kid, not thinking about war, displacement, or loss.

Svitlo is truly my second home. It's not just a school but a community that has **shaped** me in so many ways. When I joined, I found more than just a place to learn-I found friends, support, and a sense of belonging. During difficult times, Yulia and Daria and all the volunteers were always there, offering encouragement and reminding me that I wasn't alone. MY SCHOOL EXPERIENCE

When the war started, I moved to Poland, and my school switched to online learning. At first, it felt like we were all in the same situation, but my classmates soon returned to offline classes, while I stayed in Poland, struggling with online studies.

In reality, I wasn't really learning. Teachers often forgot about me, the internet would cut out, and I couldn't see anything on Zoom. It felt more like being a passive observer than a student, and only a few teachers ever reached out, making it even more isolating.

ABOUT THE WAR

The war took so much from me—people, stability, and a sense of belonging. It **shattered the normalcy** I once knew.

It took people—friends and family who left, some never to return. It took support—feeling forgotten at school and disconnected from classmates.

It took my home—Poland felt unfamiliar, and I didn't belong.

It took my routine—everything I once knew was disrupted, and I had to rebuild my life. Most of all, it took time—time that should've been spent growing and learning, but instead was spent surviving.



ABOUT SVITLO

Svitlo was a lifeline when I felt completely isolated. When my education in Ukraine became nearly impossible due to constant disconnections and a lack of engagement, Svitlo gave me structure, support, and a sense of belonging. What stands out most is that Svitlo isn't just about academics—it's a caring community. Teachers and mentors don't just teach; they and encourage, quide students as individuals, not just names on a list. For the first time. I felt like my education mattered, and I wasn't left behind because of my situation. The program's flexibility allowed me to study at my own pace, something I'd always needed. Svitlo also boosted confidence, showing me I'm capable of more than I realized. It opened doors to mentorship, global projects, and leadership roles, helping me rediscover my motivation to grow both academically and personally.



ABOUT THE WAR


