

INITIATION TO CHAKRAS





4th Chakra — The Heart



The heart was for the ancient Egyptians the most important organ of the human being. It was left inside the body after mummification because a mummy buried without it, could not be reborn: it would die a final death.

In medical, magical and religious texts, the heart is given two names: **Ib** and **Haty**.

Anubis magically extracted Ib (the heart representing conscience and morality) and placed it on one of the two scale plates.

Scale of Justice

The Ib was counterbalanced by the feather of Maat (symbol of Truth and Universal Justice), placed on the other pan.

The scales represent the equality with which Justice treats everyone.





ISIS

The Wings of Isis - symbol of purity, elevation and evolution.

An experience of being penetrated by knowledge.

Goddesses ISIS and AMAUNET.

The Great Mother Isis, initiator par excellence.

Wisdom, Truth and Power.

She instructed humanity in the mysteries.

What is the 4th Chakra?

It is the Intelligence of the Heart ("Nous")- the Higher Mind and Justice.

It represents the leap from the concrete to the abstract and the higher. It is the passage from the linear to the holistic.

The administration of equality and justice, honour, loyalty, certainty, alignment, collaboration and harmony.

The Heart – Neutralising Force

- It is the Higher Mind without labels or preconceived ideas.
- State of Being and not an identity.
- Knowing.
- Heart is not emotional involvement.
- Love, Feeling without attachment.
- Balance between thinking and knowledge.
- Tolerance.
- Good judgement.
- Unconditionality.




- Breaks all patterns.

The Heart - Unbalanced

"When you think you are in the heart, you are usually not."

- Excessive seriousness
- Superficiality
- Insensitivity
- Forced harmony
- Self-satisfied righteousness
- Master of Illusion/ Illusion of holiness
- Projection rather than acceptance
- The energies of the lower centres projected as spirituality sentimentality
- Imitation
- "Bleeding heart" imaginary compassion and love
- Stays in the personal and does not reach the consciousness of the collective



What does it represent in an **initiation** process?

Once mastery of the personal energy bodies and the lower centres (minor initiations) is achieved, one moves on to the first Great Initiation. This represents the dimensional leap into the Higher and holistic Mind.

A relationship with the emerging reality is initiated; what we call the Higher Self, in Inner Alchemy.

If not "aligned" with these forces, the neophyte will NOT be admitted to the Temple.

Have you honoured the voice of your heart in all your actions?


Have you loved unselfishly?
