What to Bring

How to Get There

There is limited parking at the pavilion, and we want to be kind to the Boathouse and avoid using their parking. Some parking will also be available in the parking lot across from Rodeheaver Auditorium.

Here's the plan:

- You may drop off your food, chairs, and other people at the pavilion.
- Then, park at the church.
- Shuttles will run from the church parking lot to the pavilion and will bring you back afterward.
- Parking spaces at the pavilion will be reserved for those needing handicap parking or assistance getting around.
