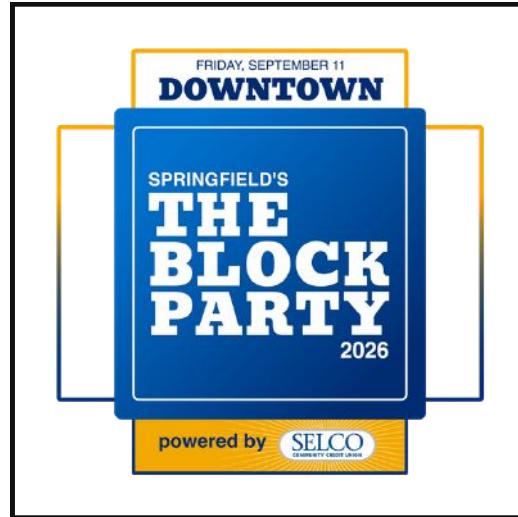
What is **The Block Party**?

On September 5th, 2025, 15,000 people descended on Historic Downtown Springfield for Lane County's Largest One Day Party. Over **140 participating organizations** with assets from **\$1k to \$2.8 Billion**, came together to celebrate economic growth, arts, culture, craft food, beverage and community building, in the heart of our City Center. Springfield's The Block Party is an annual showcase of the revitalization of Springfield: **One Magical Night, Many Years in the Making.**

As the city starts its 140th year, The Block Party is poised as **the premier free gathering** in Lane County where businesses, non-profits, and civic partners can connect with their community, building the future of our region for the next generation of Oregonians. We are honored to bring together all of Springfield, in conjunction with the annual Herencia Hispana (Hispanic Heritage) Celebration.

We support a healthy and vibrant community through our 501c3 charity Community Activation Network who organizes The Block Party as a small, mostly volunteer team.
