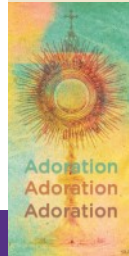

St. Thomas Parish is happy to welcome all people to our faith community. If you live in this area, we invite you to register as a parishioner. Registration forms in both English and Español are available in the Gathering Area of the church.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

How many people will there be in heaven? I'm sure it's something we've all wondered about every so often. The Church's tradition on this point is a bit complicated: God desires the salvation of every human being, but he also respects our freedom of choice to be with him or not. That complexity is the reason why Jesus sort of brushes off a question about someone who wants to take a census of heaven's population. His basic point is that instead of getting distracted by questions that are way above our paygrade, we should focus in on two things: making sure that we ourselves get to heaven, and doing everything we can to bring as many people along with us as we can.

This principle touches on many aspects of our life of faith, from our Sunday celebrations to our individual prayers to our works of charity. For this weekend, I'd like to ask everyone to think about the second part: how do we get as many people to heaven with us as possible?

We're currently in the process of starting our OCIA program for the year: our "new members class," the main way that we respond to the needs of people seeking unity with Christ and his Church. (This has been called "RCIA" for many years, but the US bishops decided to rename it "OCIA" a couple years ago, and the new name is still percolating.) We will have an inquiry session on August the 26th at 6:30pm, and the formal program will begin September the 9th (a week after Labor Day). As a part of our focus on mission this year, I invite everyone to think and pray about anyone you know that might be interested. I'm sure we all know someone that has questions and would like to learn more about God. As a second step, please give them a personal invitation to come to St. Thomas and check out our OCIA.

And for anyone reading this who might be considering becoming Catholic, as well as Catholics who need to finish your sacraments, you are also very welcome to join us. It is a tremendous joy every year to walk with people who are experiencing God's presence in new ways, and I look forward to getting to know you.

Through the intercession of Mary, the Mother of Apostles, and our patron St. Thomas, may we all find the wisdom and courage to bring someone in our lives to the Lord Jesus.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

¿Cuántas personas habrá en el cielo? Estoy seguro de que todos nos lo hemos preguntado de vez en cuando. La Iglesia enseña dos cosas: Dios quiere la salvación de todos, y al mismo tiempo respeta nuestra libertad para decirle sí o no. Por eso, cuando le hacen a Jesús una pregunta como queriendo "contar" a los que se van a salvar, él no se engancha. Su punto es sencillo: en lugar de distraernos con cosas que no nos tocan, enfoquémonos en dos tareas: asegurarnos de llegar al cielo y hacer todo lo posible para llevar a muchos con nosotros.

Este principio toca muchos aspectos de nuestra vida de fe: nuestras misas del domingo, la oración de cada día y las obras de caridad. Para este fin de semana, quiero pedirles que pensemos en la segunda parte: ¿cómo logramos que vayan al cielo con nosotros todas las personas que podamos?

Estamos por iniciar nuestro programa de OCIA para este año: es nuestra "clase para nuevos miembros", la manera principal en que acompañamos a quienes buscan unirse a Cristo y a su Iglesia. (Se llama "OCIA", pero por muchos años se conoció como "RCIA" o "RICA", y el nuevo nombre todavía se está adoptando.). Tendremos una sesión de información el 26 de agosto a las 6:30 p.m., y el programa formal comenzará el 9 de septiembre (una semana después del Día del Trabajo). Como parte de nuestro enfoque en la misión este año, les invito a pensar y orar por alguna persona que ustedes conozcan y que pueda estar interesada. Seguro todos conocemos a alguien con preguntas que quiere aprender más de Dios. Después, den ese segundo paso: háganle una invitación personal para que venga a Santo Tomás y conozca nuestro OCIA.

Y a ti que estás leyendo esto: si estás pensando en hacerte católico, o si como católico te faltan sacramentos, también eres muy bienvenido. Cada año es un gran gozo caminar con personas que están experimentando la presencia de Dios de maneras nuevas. Me dará mucho gusto conocerlo.

Por intercesión de la Virgen María, Madre de los Apóstoles, y de nuestro patrono, santo Tomás, pidamos la sabiduría y el valor para acercar a alguien de nuestras vidas al Señor Jesús.
