





Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Es una alegría inmensa y un privilegio ver cada día los rostros de nuestros primeros alumnos, y creo que a todos se nos enternece el corazón al verlos con su uniforme parroquial. Para mí es una bendición personal saber que cada niño y cada niña de la escuela proviene de una familia de nuestra parroquia. Parece algo obvio, pero en realidad es muy poco común en las escuelas católicas de hoy. A todos los que han apoyado esta obra con su oración, con su generosidad y con su servicio, muchas gracias de corazón. Todavía queda mucho por hacer para que la promesa de la educación católica llegue a todos los miembros de la parroquia en los años por venir, pero tengo plena confianza en que el mismo Dios que ha iniciado esta obra buena aquí, seguirá sosteniéndonos.

Segundo, la Universidad de Montevallo ha iniciado su semestre y la pastoral universitaria ya está en pleno movimiento. A los estudiantes nuevos que quizá estén leyendo esta carta, quiero darles una invitación especial a participar en nuestro "Spirit Night" cada semana: los miércoles a las 5:30pm, con Misa, una comida, y un tiempo de convivencia y estudio bíblico. ¡Anímense a venir! Y a cualquier feligrés que quisiera participar en este ministerio universitario, siempre estamos en busca de más voluntarios para nuestros equipos de servicio.
