Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As we move into the fall program season, there are so many wonderful things going on at St Thomas. The school is going great, it's been wonderful to see all our students back for Faith Formation, and I'm excited by the number of people that have come to our OCIA inquiry classes. We might be still waiting for the actual fall weather, but the exciting times are certainly here.

We have a couple special things going on right now that I wanted to highlight. First, I hope most parishioners have had a chance to meet our seminarian, Justin Brouillette. But just in case you missed the weekend when we introduced him, here's the nutshell. One of the milestones for many seminarians is what's called a "pastoral year," essentially a year of residency to gain experience applying their education in a parish and to experience the life of a priest in a more first-hand way. Justin is joining us for one of these. He grew up at Our Lady of Sorrows and has completed three years of seminary so far. Be sure to introduce yourself if you haven't already, and definitely keep him in your prayers!

Second, you'll notice that the liturgy this weekend is a bit unusual. We are interrupting the normal cycle of "green" Sundays in Ordinary Time for the feast day assigned to September 14th: the Feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross. We celebrate the feast every year, but since it falls on a Sunday this year, we are observing it in a more public way. The feast marks the occasion 1700 years ago when Christianity was legalized in the Roman Empire and the Christians of the city of Jerusalem brought the Cross of Christ out of hiding for veneration by all the faithful. As you might imagine, it was a very joyous occasion, and even all these centuries later, the feast day is observed as a sort of miniature Good Friday. Since the meaning of the events of that individual day is worth contemplating throughout the year, it's good that we have this opportunity to place the mystery of the Cross foremost in our minds, even in the midst of Ordinary Time (the season of the Holy Spirit at work in the Church).

As we celebrate this day, I would propose for our reflection and prayer a few lines of an ancient poem in honor of the Cross of Christ, from the pen of St Venantius Fortunatus (one of the great poets of the Christian tradition, who lived in the late 500s). The occasion of the hymn was for a procession with a relic of the Cross:

Hail, holy Cross, our only hope
In every time of trial and pain.
Strengthen the faithful, make them just,
And bring us sinners peace again.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo:

Al comenzar la temporada de programas de otoño, hay tantas cosas hermosas sucediendo en San Tomás. La escuela marcha muy bien, ha sido una alegría ver de nuevo a todos nuestros estudiantes en la Formación en la Fe, y me llena de entusiasmo el número de personas que han llegado a nuestras clases de consulta del OCIA. Quizá aún tengamos que esperar un poco para el clima otoñal de verdad, pero lo cierto es que estos son tiempos emocionantes.

En este momento hay un par de cosas especiales que quiero resaltar. Primero, espero que la mayoría de los feligreses ya haya tenido la oportunidad de conocer a nuestro seminarista, Justin Brouillette. Pero, por si acaso alguien se perdió el fin de semana en que lo presentamos, aquí va un pequeño resumen. Uno de los hitos para muchos seminaristas es lo que se llama un "año pastoral": básicamente, un año de residencia para adquirir experiencia aplicando su formación en una parroquia y para conocer de cerca la vida de un sacerdote. Justin está con nosotros precisamente para eso. Creció en la parroquia de Our Lady of Sorrows y ya ha completado tres años de seminario. Si todavía no se han presentado, los invito a hacerlo, y sobre todo les pido que lo tengan presente en sus oraciones.

Segundo, notarán que la liturgia de este fin de semana es un poco distinta. Estamos interrumpiendo el ciclo normal de domingos "verdes" del Tiempo Ordinario para celebrar la fiesta que corresponde al 14 de septiembre: la Fiesta de la Exaltación de la Santa Cruz. La celebramos cada año, pero al caer en domingo en esta ocasión, la vivimos de una manera más pública y solemne. Esta fiesta recuerda el momento, hace ya 1700 años, en que el cristianismo fue legalizado en el Imperio Romano y los cristianos de Jerusalén sacaron la Cruz de Cristo de su escondite para la veneración de todos los fieles. Como pueden imaginar, fue una ocasión muy gozosa, y aun siglos después, la Iglesia conserva la memoria de ese día como una especie de Viernes Santo en miniatura. Y porque el misterio de aquel acontecimiento merece nuestra contemplación durante todo el año, es providencial que tengamos esta oportunidad de poner la Cruz en el centro de nuestra oración, aun en medio del Tiempo Ordinario (la estación en la que celebramos la acción del Espíritu Santo en la Iglesia).

Al celebrar este día, quisiera proponer para nuestra reflexión y oración unos versos de un antiguo poema en honor de la Cruz de Cristo, obra de san Venancio Fortunato (uno de los grandes poetas de la tradición cristiana, que vivió a fines del siglo VI). El himno fue compuesto para una procesión con una reliquia de la Cruz:

¡Salve, oh Cruz, esperanza fiel!
 En esta hora de dolor,
 Aumenta al justo su poder,
 Concédenos tu gran perdón,

**Dios los bendiga,
 Padre Jantz**
