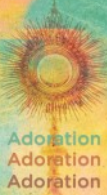

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our first reading today reports the words of the prophet Habakkuk, in a moment of frustration that the prophecies he had given had not yet come true. God reassures him that the dreams inspired in the prophet's heart will come to fulfillment, strengthening both his patience and his faith.

As I look back over the last few years at St Thomas, it's amazing how many dreams have come true for our parish, in God's good time and with our community coming together. Seeing our parish be so effective in evangelization; watching the school open; experiencing the growth in ministries and those working and volunteering in them. As we start our Stewardship Month, I would like to begin by calling to mind how those dreams have come true due to God's goodness and our community's commitment.

One of the great signs of God's providence has been the sudden and unexpected opening of programs that help fund private schools for middle- and lower-income families. We hadn't seen some of those coming when we started discerning the possibility of the school (25 years ago!), but they became available just as we were getting going, and they have made a difference.

An important program that many people participated in last year and that made a difference (over \$50,000 worth!) for our school was through a program called "Scholarship Granting Organizations." Many thanks to everyone who participated. By way of explanation to anyone less familiar with this, here in Alabama, we have a program that allows anyone who pays state taxes to designate some of the tax money to fund scholarships for kids to attend accredited private schools (such as Catholic schools). Basically, if you contribute to one of them, you can then count it as part of your state taxes for the year. It's a classic two for one special: you help out a child, and you fulfill your civic responsibility of paying taxes. As part of our effort to open a parish school at St. Thomas, we have partnered with one of those organizations, called "Alabama Scholarships for Kids," and we are working on getting as many parishioners as possible to participate to bring those funds into our school. We're working with them to put together both resources and information sessions to help everyone participate. Specifically, I would like to invite everyone to an event on Sunday, the 19th of October, at 9:30am, in the main church, where we will have a "coach" walk us through how it works, answer any questions, and make sure you have his contact info so you can reach out with any questions as tax time approaches. If you're not able to make it, we'll keep the resources available in the gathering space.

I know this kind of tax stuff can seem confusing and mysterious, but taking the time to do this will make a huge difference here at St Thomas. It's one way to help live up to Jesus' prayer that all of us do mighty deeds in his name. As a community, through the intercession of Blessed Mary, Ever-Virgin, and our patron St Thomas, let's take care of the little ones entrusted to us.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Nuestra primera lectura de hoy recoge las palabras del profeta Habacuc, en un momento de frustración porque las profecías que había proclamado aún no se cumplían. Dios lo consuela asegurándole que los sueños que Él mismo había inspirado en el corazón del profeta llegarán a cumplirse, fortaleciendo así su paciencia y su fe.

Al mirar hacia atrás en estos últimos años en San Tomás, es impresionante ver cuántos sueños se han hecho realidad en nuestra parroquia, en el tiempo oportuno de Dios y gracias a la unión de nuestra comunidad. Ver cómo nuestra parroquia se ha vuelto tan fecunda en la evangelización; haber inaugurado la escuela; experimentar el crecimiento de los ministerios y de quienes trabajan y sirven en ellos. Al comenzar nuestro Mes de la Corresponsabilidad, quiero invitarles primero a recordar cómo todos esos sueños se han cumplido por la bondad de Dios y por el compromiso de nuestra comunidad.

Uno de los grandes signos de la providencia de Dios ha sido la apertura de programas que ayudan a financiar escuelas privadas para familias de ingresos medios y bajos. Cuando comenzamos a discernir la posibilidad de abrir la escuela, no nos imaginábamos que esos programas existirían, pero llegaron justo en el momento en que los necesitábamos, y han hecho la diferencia.

Un programa muy importante en el que muchos participaron el año pasado—y que significó más de \$50,000 para nuestra escuela—fue a través de lo que se llama “Organizaciones de Becas Educativas” (Scholarship Granting Organizations). Muchas gracias a todos los que colaboraron. Para explicar un poco a quienes no estén tan familiarizados: aquí en Alabama tenemos un programa que permite a cualquier persona que paga impuestos estatales designar parte de ese dinero para financiar becas que permiten a niños asistir a escuelas privadas acreditadas (como las escuelas católicas). Básicamente, si uno contribuye a una de esas organizaciones, esa cantidad cuenta como parte de los impuestos estatales del año. Es como una oferta de dos por uno: ayudas a un niño y, al mismo tiempo, cumples con tu responsabilidad cívica de pagar impuestos. Como parte de nuestro esfuerzo por abrir la escuela parroquial en San Tomás, nos hemos asociado con una de esas organizaciones llamada “Alabama Scholarships for Kids,” y estamos trabajando para que el mayor número posible de feligreses participen, de modo que esos fondos lleguen a nuestra escuela. Estamos preparando, junto con ellos, tanto materiales como sesiones de información para ayudar a todos a involucrarse. En concreto, quiero invitarles a un evento el domingo 19 de octubre, a las 9:30 de la mañana, en la iglesia principal, donde un “entrenador” nos guiará paso a paso, responderá preguntas y les dará su información de contacto para que puedan comunicarse con él cuando se acerque la temporada de impuestos. Si no pueden asistir, mantendremos los recursos disponibles en el área de convivencia. Sé que este tipo de temas de impuestos puede parecer confuso o misterioso, pero dedicar un poco de tiempo a esto hará una gran diferencia aquí en San Tomás. Es una manera concreta de vivir la oración de Jesús: que todos nosotros realicemos obras grandes en su nombre. Como comunidad, por la intercesión de la Bienaventurada Virgen María y de nuestro patrono Santo Tomás, cuidemos juntos de los pequeños que el Señor nos ha confiado.
