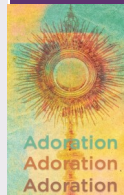

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our stewardship month continues onwards! Many thanks to all of those who have participated so far. Your generosity truly makes a difference for the mission of our parish. For this week's pastoral column, I'd like to focus on a key quality of good stewards: faith. I think faith is key for stewardship for a couple reasons. Faith: the spiritual gift that causes us to choose to follow Christ. The attitude of the heart that lets us turn to God in confidence. Or more simply, trust in God. Let's talk about why it's so important for stewardship.

First, we're not called to be good stewards because of social expectations or "Catholic guilt." We do it because of our faith in Jesus Christ, who gave everything for us on the Cross. As St. Paul says in this weekend's second reading, "Remain faithful to what you have learned and believed." Faith reminds us that before we ever even thought about generosity, God was infinitely generous to us in his Son, Jesus. In other words, faith is the reason we strive to be good stewards.

Second, faith gives us confidence that even the little bit that we have can make a difference. Some years ago, I was part of a parish choir that had a member who was special needs. He found singing very challenging, but the whole parish deeply appreciated the joy that he brought with him each week. His faith that God would work through his talent and time was a genuine inspiration for all of us. Faith truly gives us the confidence to be good stewards.

Through the example of faith set by our patron St. Thomas, and the same faith which shines forth in the life of the Blessed Virgin Mary, let's open our hearts and our hands in faith, this month and always.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

¡Nuestro mes de corresponsabilidad continúa! Muchas gracias a todos que han participado. Su generosidad hace una grande diferencia para la misión de nuestra parroquia.

Para la carta pastoral de esta semana, me gustaría reflexionar en una cualidad importante para la corresponsabilidad en la Iglesia: la fe. Creo que la fe es clave aquí por un par de razones. Fe: el don espiritual que nos hace decidir de seguir a Cristo. La actitud del corazón que nos permite volvernos a Dios con confianza. O más simplemente, la confianza en Dios. Hablemos de por qué es tan importante en nuestra esperanza de ser hechos de la Palabra y no solo conferenciantes.

Primero, no estamos llamados a la corresponsabilidad en la Iglesia debido a las expectativas sociales. Lo hacemos por nuestra fe en Jesucristo, quien lo dio todo por nosotros en la Cruz. Como dice San Pablo en la segunda lectura de este fin de semana: “Permanece firme en lo que has aprendido y se te ha confiado”. La fe nos recuerda que antes de que siquiera pensáramos en la generosidad, Dios fue infinitamente generoso con nosotros en su Hijo, Jesús. En otras palabras, la fe es la razón por la que nos esforzamos por ser responsables con las bendiciones que Dios nos ha dado.

En segundo lugar, la fe nos da la confianza de que incluso lo poco que tenemos puede hacer una diferencia. Hace algunos años, yo era parte de un coro parroquial que tenía un miembro con necesidades especiales.
