



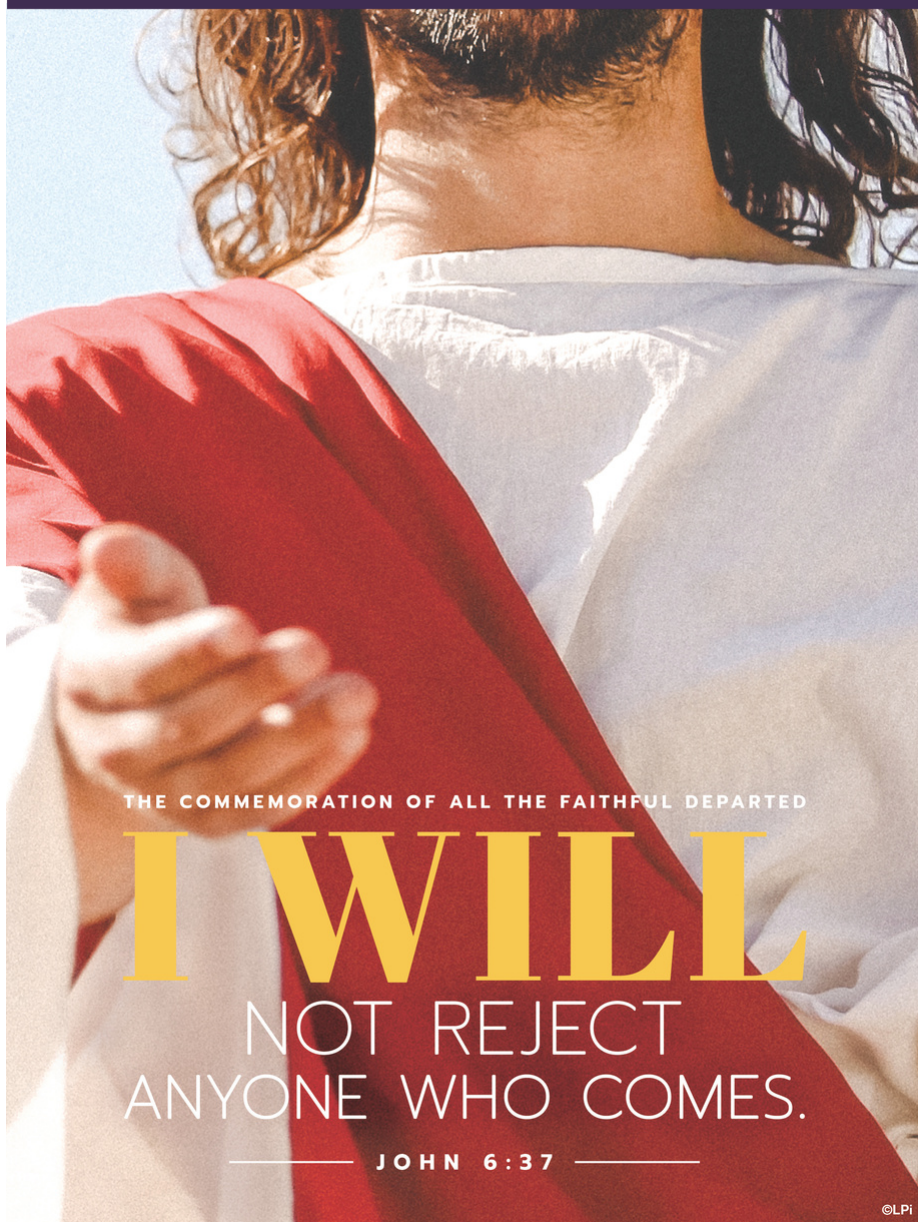

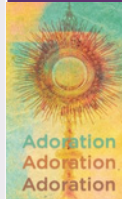

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Many thanks to everyone who has worked so hard to make our Stewardship Month such a success. From the lay leaders who helped with the ministry fair, to everyone who was so generous with committing to support the church in many ways, to the staff members who worked behind the scenes to make it all come together—thank you very much. And thank you as well to everyone involved in or coming out for our Fall Festival this weekend. What a wonderful occasion!

As we begin to get ready for the big holiday celebrations, November is a more solemn time of year. Maybe it's because the changing of the leaves colors reminds us how things change, and the falling of the leaves reminds us that our time is short and precious. In the Church, November is a time when we call to mind our departed loved ones, and also a time when we recall the basic realities of our life. This is a month when Catholics are asked to reflect on "the Four Last Things:" death and judgment, heaven and hell.

I know that all sounds very serious. But I don't bring it up because I want to be gloomy, or because my neighbors have some spooky decorations out! I think we should think about those things, because it helps keep everything in perspective. When we remember that life is short and eternity is long, it helps us make much better decisions. And speaking from my own experience, when I make a point of keeping this in focus, I feel not only closer to God, but I also feel much happier in every other aspect of life.

There's a quote I like from St. Sharbel Makhluf, a 19th-century monk from Lebanon: "Do not start anything on earth if it does not end in heaven. Do not walk on a path on earth that does not lead to heaven." That's the healthiest perspective we can have on the Last Things. The mystic's words remind us that the stakes are high, and that our choices now can set us on a path that leads to eternal joy.

So let's ponder our priorities over the coming month while as a parish community we remember our dearly departed ones and reflect on the Last Things. Through the intercession of Blessed Mary, Ever-Virgin, and our patron Saint Thomas, let's learn to live each day in the light of eternity.

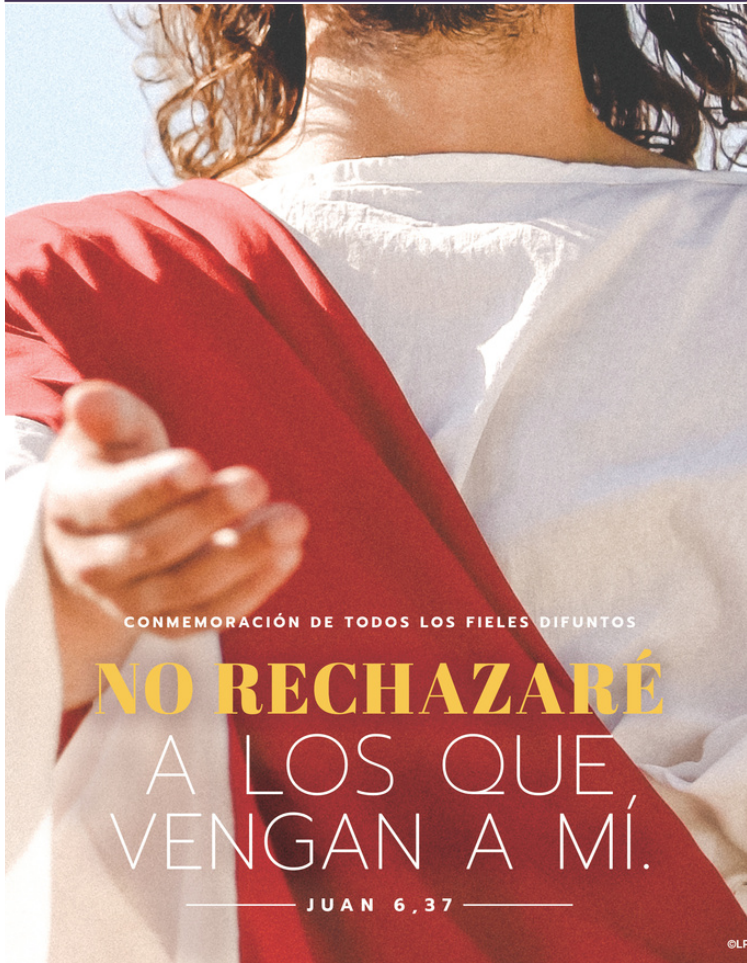
Annulment Advocates

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Muchísimas gracias a todos los que han trabajado con tanto esfuerzo para que nuestro Mes de Corresponsabilidad haya sido un verdadero éxito. Desde los líderes laicos que colaboraron en la feria de ministerios, hasta todos los que han sido tan generosos comprometiéndose a apoyar a la parroquia de muchas maneras, y también a los miembros del personal que trabajaron tras bambalinas para que todo saliera bien: muchas gracias. Y gracias también a todos los que participaron o asistieron a nuestro Festival de Otoño este fin de semana. ¡Qué ocasión tan maravillosa!

Ahora que comenzamos a prepararnos para las grandes celebraciones de fin de año, noviembre es un tiempo más solemne. Tal vez sea porque los cambios en los colores de las hojas nos recuerdan cómo todo cambia, y el hecho de que caigan nos recuerda que nuestro tiempo es corto y valioso. En la Iglesia, noviembre es un mes en el que hacemos memoria de nuestros seres queridos difuntos, y también un tiempo para recordar las grandes realidades de nuestra existencia. Es el mes en que se nos invita a reflexionar sobre “las Cuatro Postrimerías”: muerte, juicio, cielo e infierno.

Sé que todo esto suena muy serio. Pero no lo menciono porque quiera ser sombrío. Lo menciono porque reflexionar sobre estas realidades nos ayuda a mantener una perspectiva correcta. Cuando recordamos que la vida es breve y la eternidad es larga, tomamos decisiones mucho más sabias. Y, por mi propia experiencia, cuando hago un esfuerzo por mantener esto presente, me siento no solo más cerca de Dios, sino también mucho más feliz en todos los demás aspectos de mi vida.

Hay una frase que me gusta mucho de San Charbel Makhlouf, un monje del siglo XIX del Líbano: “No comiences nada en la tierra si no termina en el cielo.
