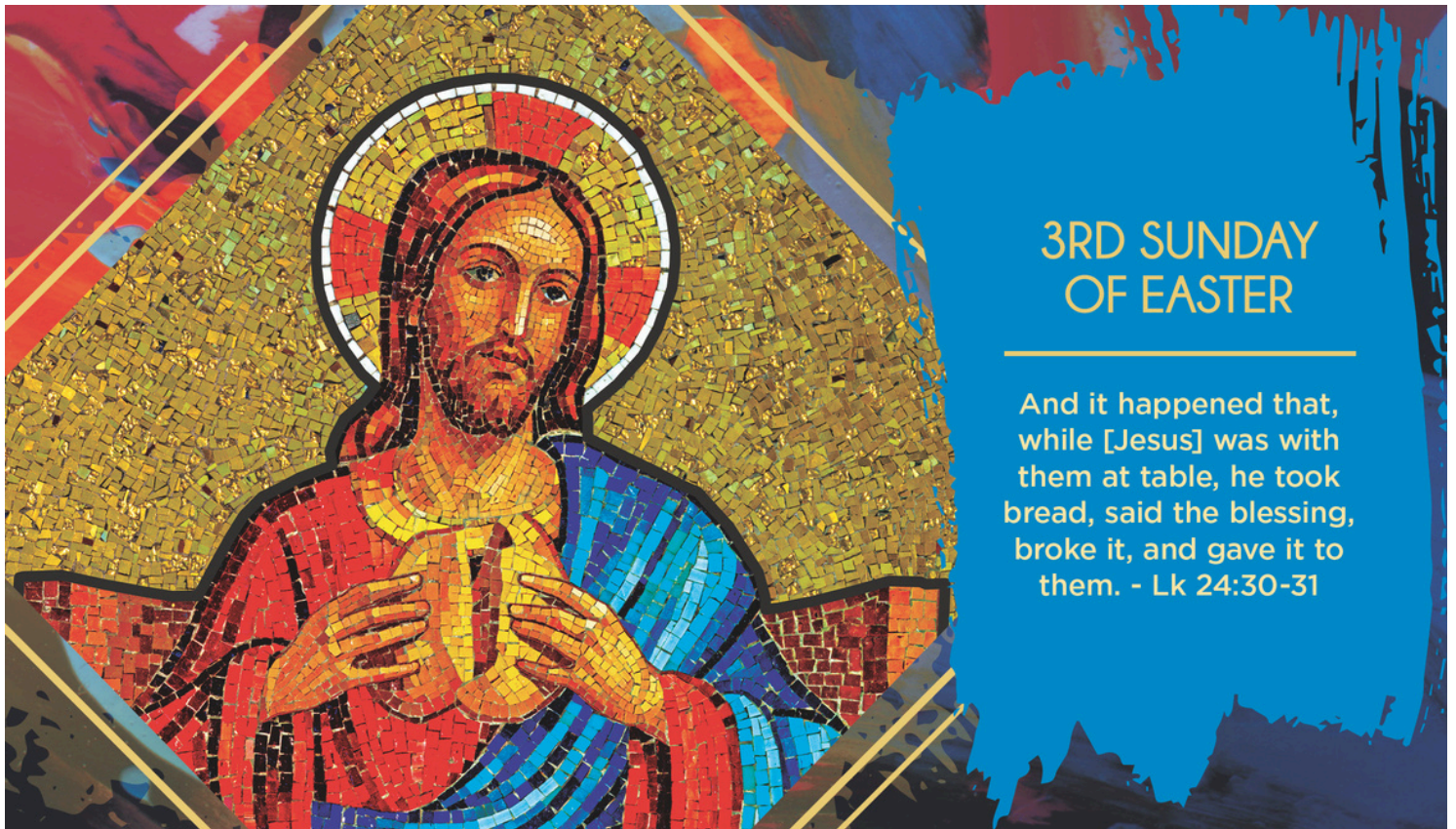

## PASTOR'S LETTER



Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

In the ancient church, the Easter season was considered a time of “mystagogy:” going deeper into the mysteries of our redemption. In those days, the newly baptized heard the Creed and saw the celebration of the Eucharist for the first time after the Easter Vigil. Then everyone would reflect more deeply on those central truths of the faith in the weeks after Easter, seeing them anew through the eyes of the recently initiated.

With that in mind, I'd like to mention a few things going on in the parish that can help us make this season a time of mystagogy for us, as well. First, for the next few weeks, I'm planning to preach on the reasons for the hope within us: why do we believe what we believe? How does the experience of hope in Christ change our lives? If you need that message, I hope what I have to say resonates with you. And if you know someone else who needs it, be sure to invite them!

Second, we're coming to the end of the Faith Formation year, which means that it is almost time to register for next year. For families with kids of the appropriate ages (kindergarten through 8th grade, plus high school Confirmation), please be on the look-out for early registration information. Let's make sure that the youngest members of our community have a chance to go deeper with their faith!

Third, as you make your summer plans, be sure to circle the week of June 22-26, which will be our Vacation Bible School. This is always a great moment for people across our parish to come together and give our young people a great experience of God's love. I look forward to seeing you there!

In this Easter season, may the intercession of the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. Thomas lead us all more deeply into the wondrous mystery of Christ's all-merciful love.

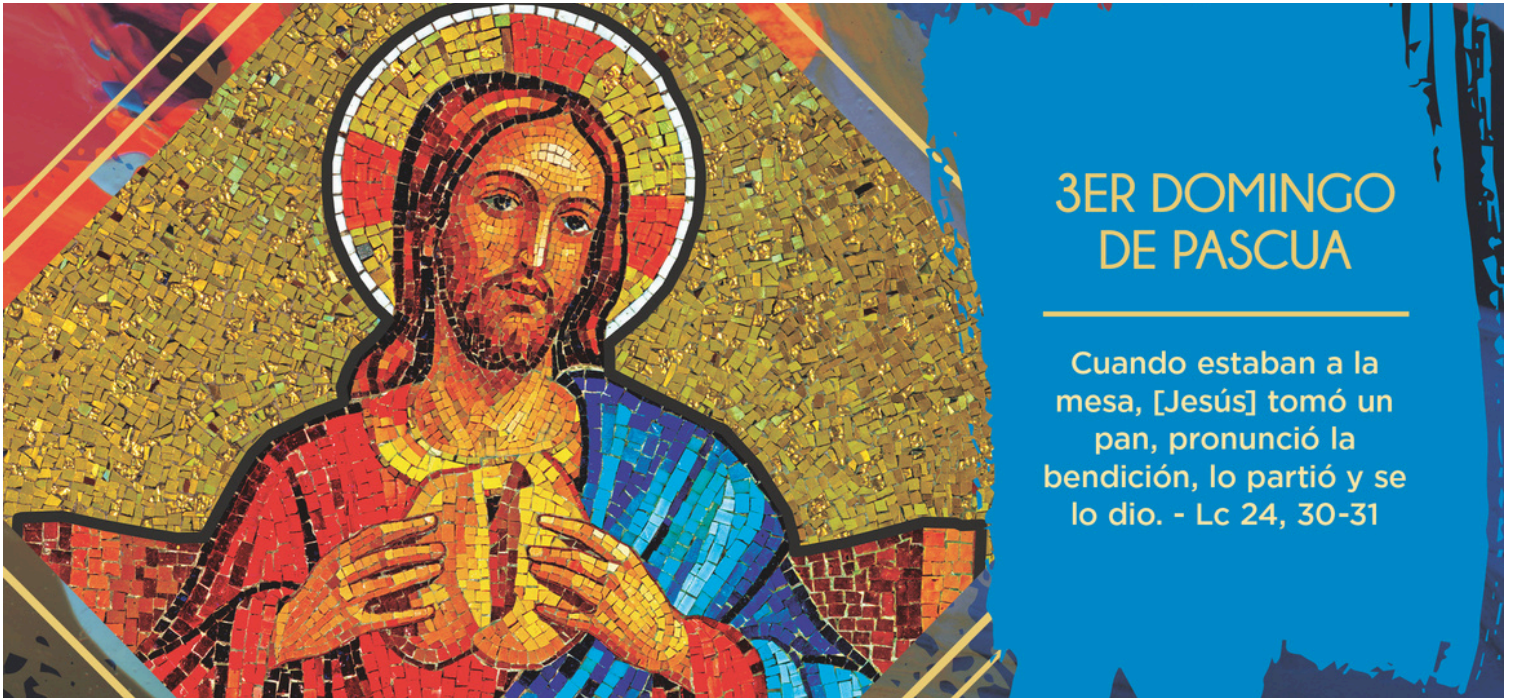

### CARTA DEL SACERDOTE

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

En los primeros siglos de la Iglesia, el tiempo pascual se consideraba un tiempo de “mistagogia”: un tiempo para profundizar en los misterios de nuestra redención. En aquellos días, los recién bautizados escuchaban el Credo y presenciaban la celebración de la Eucaristía por primera vez después de ser bautizados en la Vigilia Pascual. Luego, todos reflexionaban más profundamente sobre esas verdades centrales de la fe en las semanas posteriores a la Pascua, viéndolas renovadas a través de los ojos de los recién iniciados.

Con esto en mente, quisiera mencionar algunas actividades en la parroquia que pueden ayudarnos a que este tiempo sea también un tiempo de mistagogia para nosotros. Primero, durante las próximas semanas, planeo predicar sobre las razones de la esperanza en nosotros: ¿por qué creemos lo que creemos? ¿Cómo transforma nuestra vida la experiencia de la esperanza en Cristo? Si necesitase este mensaje, espero que lo que tengo que decir te resuene. Y si conoces a alguien más que lo necesite, ¡no duden en invitarlo!

En segundo lugar, estamos llegando al final del año de Formación en la Fe, lo que significa que pronto será el momento de inscribir a los niños para el próximo año. Para las familias con niños de las edades apropiadas (desde kínder hasta octavo grado, además de la confirmación en la preparatoria), estén atentos a la información sobre la inscripción anticipada. ¡Asegurémonos de que los miembros más jóvenes de nuestra comunidad tengan la oportunidad de profundizar en su fe! En tercer lugar, al hacer sus planes para el verano, no olviden marcar la semana del 22 al 26 de junio, que será nuestras Vacaciones con Jesús. Este siempre es un momento especial para que la comunidad parroquial se reúna y brinde a nuestros jóvenes una gran experiencia del amor de Dios. ¡Los espero allí!

En esta Pascua, que la intercesión de la Santísima Virgen María y Santo Tomás nos guíe a todos a profundizar en el maravilloso misterio del amor misericordioso de Cristo.
