PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We come this weekend to the Feast of Pentecost, the conclusion of the Easter season. Or maybe to put it a bit better, the *fulfillment* of the Easter season, when the mystery of Jesus' Resurrection changed the lives and hearts of the disciples. With their experience of the sacraments of the first Easter, they received the Holy Spirit, and they began to preach Christ to the world.



I think we're at a similar point of transition here at St. Thomas in 2026. We've been celebrating the new presence of Jesus' Cross and Resurrection to so many people in so many ways for the past couple months: the many members of our OCIA class, the over 90 young disciples confirmed, and the roughly 120 young people who have recently made their First Holy Communion. Not to mention many baptisms (about 100 in the past year!), and the People of God gathering each week to continue experiencing what Christ has done for us.

Before we head out into the long, green season—Ordinary Time, the time of the Church and the time of our mission—we gather to be renewed by the power of the Holy Spirit. I'd ask you to join me in praying for his power and guidance for our parish over the coming months. I would also pass along an invitation to a special event: Deacons John Paul Stepnowski, Andrew Vickery, and John Gardiner will be ordained as priests this Saturday (30 May) at 11am at the Cathedral of St. Paul. I wouldn't miss it for the world, and I would love to have a good representation from the parish to celebrate together with our entire Diocese.

Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful. Enkindle in them the fire of your love. Send forth your Spirit, and they shall be created, and you will renew the face of the earth. Amen!

CARTA DEL SACERDOTE

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo,

Este fin de semana celebramos la Fiesta de Pentecostés, la culminación del tiempo pascual. O, mejor dicho, la plenitud del tiempo pascual, cuando el misterio de la Resurrección de Jesús transformó la vida y el corazón de los discípulos. Al experimentar los sacramentos de la primera Pascua, recibieron el Espíritu Santo y comenzaron a predicar a Cristo al mundo.



Creo que nos encontramos en un punto de transición similar aquí en Santo Tomás en 2026. Durante los últimos meses, hemos celebrado la nueva presencia de la Cruz y la Resurrección de Jesús para muchísimas personas y de muchas maneras: los numerosos miembros de nuestra clase de OCIA, los más de 90 adolescentes confirmados y los aproximadamente 120 niños y jóvenes que recientemente hicieron su Primera Comunión. Antes de adentrarnos en el largo y verde tiempo litúrgico —el Tiempo Ordinario, el tiempo de la Iglesia y el tiempo de nuestra misión— nos reunimos para renovarnos con el poder del Espíritu Santo. Les pido que se unan a mí en oración para que su poder y guía acompañen a nuestra parroquia durante los próximos meses. También les extiendo una invitación a un evento especial: los diáconos John Paul Stepnowski, Andrew Vickery y John Gardiner serán ordenados sacerdotes este sábado 30 de mayo a las 11:00 a. m. en la Catedral de San Pablo. No me lo perdería por nada del mundo, y me encantaría contar con una buena representación de la parroquia para celebrar junto con toda nuestra diócesis.

Ven, Espíritu Santo, llena los corazones de tus fieles y enciende en ellos el fuego de tu amor. Envía tu Espíritu y serán creadas todas las cosas, y renovarás la faz de la tierra. ¡Amen!
