PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Over the last few years, our parish has been blessed to host a number of seminarians. They have done wonderful work in our community, both on Sundays and also behind the scenes. More importantly, though, I think we have all enjoyed the opportunity to get to know so many young men with tremendous faith and the courage to follow God's calling. I thought I would take the opportunity this week to update everyone on a few seminarian goings-on.



First, by the time these words go to press, we will have celebrated the priestly ordination for three men who are well-known in the parish: John Paul Stepnowski, Andrew Vickery, and John Gardiner have all become friends of the St Thomas community, and it will be a lot of fun getting used to calling each of them "Father." If you run into them, be sure to ask for a blessing! And keep them in your prayers: the early days after ordination are truly joyful, but getting settled as a priest takes some time, so please continue to hold them up in the Spirit.

We had been planning a farewell bash for him, but as it turns out, the Vocations Office decided to have him stay with us for the summer! Please keep him and his on-going discernment and formation in your prayers.

Third, the Vocations Office has sent us a second seminarian for the summer. This weekend, we'll have the chance to meet Jonathan Ruscoe. I'll give him space in a future week for a formal introduction in the bulletin!

I hope that everyone feels as encouraged and blessed as I do with the opportunity to get to know so many of our seminarians. The priest shortage of recent years has reminded us of how precious a vocation to the priesthood is, and seeing firsthand how God continues to provide for us is a tremendous consolation. Through the intercession of Our Lady, Mother of the Church, and our holy patron St. Thomas, let's continue to pray for many holy priests for our diocese!
