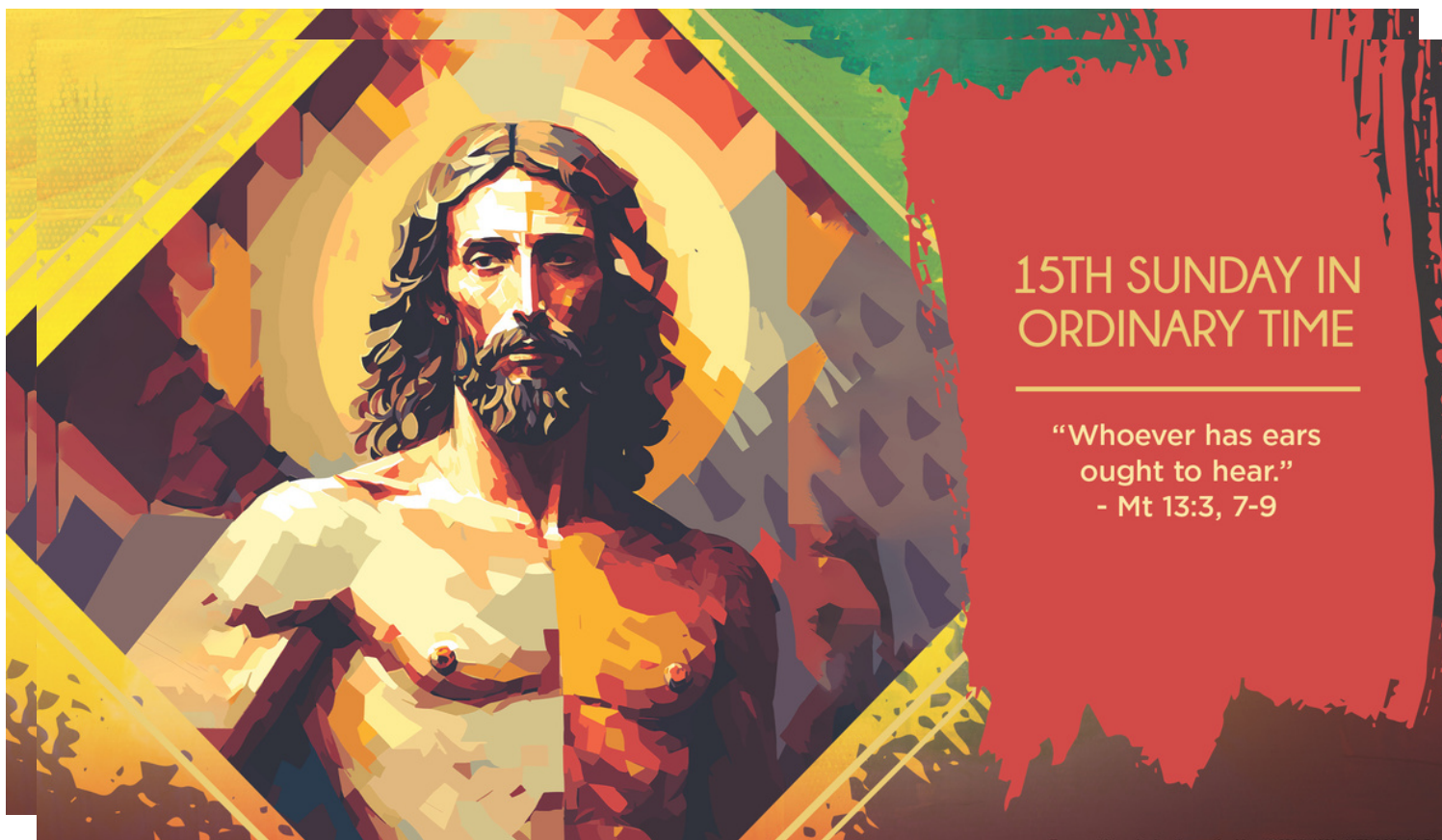

PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We have had some wonderful moments together as a community in these past months. The journey of Lent, the joy of Easter, the many people who received sacraments and came closer to God during these special seasons. There have been high feast days and wonderful community gatherings. Just in recent weeks, we have had both Vacation Bible School and the parish picnic for the Feast of St Thomas, and this weekend many of our youth and young adults are participating in the annual Steubenville conference in Atlanta. And now we come to a moment of transition: where we have to take the graces we have been given and live them out in our daily life.

We are now in the “long, green season” of the Church’s annual celebrations: ordinary time. Not because any Sunday is merely “ordinary,” though, because every Sunday is a commemoration of Jesus’ Resurrection. Rather, “ordinary” here is used in the sense of “ordinal numbers:” the Sundays are simply numbered one after the other (first, second, third, etc.) rather than being intrinsically connected with a particular portion of Christ’s Paschal Mystery. This is the season of growth and mission, when by the power of the Holy Spirit what has been given to us is shared with others.

Here is my challenge in prayer and my encouragement in faith to everyone this week: let’s ask God to help us share the gifts we have received in the past months with everyone. Whether that means inviting someone in your life to join you at Mass, or becoming involved in a new form of service, or re-committing to the daily rhythm of prayer, this is the time to make those new resolutions regarding our mission and purpose. In the coming weeks, we will hear together many of Jesus’ key teachings found in the Gospel according to St Matthew—let’s make sure that those stories are reflected in our own lives.

Through the intercession of Mary, the Mother of God, and our patron St. Thomas, we pray for our parish. Together, let’s bless God for his many gifts and continue to seek his will for our lives and our parish community.

CARTA DEL SACERDOTE

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Hemos vivido momentos muy hermosos juntos como comunidad en estos últimos meses. El camino de la Cuaresma, la alegría de la Pascua, y las muchas personas que recibieron los sacramentos y se acercaron más a Dios durante estos tiempos especiales. Hemos celebrado grandes fiestas y hermosas convivencias. Apenas en estas últimas semanas tuvimos la Escuela Bíblica de Vacaciones y el día de campo parroquial por la fiesta de santo Tomás; y este fin de semana muchos de nuestros adolescentes y jóvenes están participando en la conferencia juvenil de Steubenville, en Atlanta. Y ahora llegamos a un momento de transición: el momento de tomar las gracias que hemos recibido y vivirlas en nuestra vida diaria.

Ahora entramos en “la larga temporada verde” del año de la Iglesia: el Tiempo Ordinario. Pero no se llama “ordinario” porque algún domingo sea sin importancia, pues cada domingo es una celebración de la Resurrección de Jesús. Más bien, aquí “ordinario” viene de los “números ordinales:” los domingos simplemente se van contando uno tras otro (primero, segundo, tercero, etc.) en lugar de estar unidos a una parte particular del Misterio Pascual de Cristo. Este es el tiempo del crecimiento y de la misión, cuando, por el poder del Espíritu Santo, lo que se nos ha dado se comparte con los demás.

Este es mi desafío en la oración y mi aliento en la fe para todos esta semana: pidámosle a Dios que nos ayude a compartir con todos los dones que hemos recibido en estos meses. Ya sea invitando a alguien de su vida a que los acompañe a Misa, o comprometiéndose con un nuevo servicio, o volviendo a tomar en serio el ritmo diario de la oración, este es el momento de tomar esas nuevas decisiones sobre nuestra misión y el sentido de nuestra vida. En las próximas semanas escucharemos juntos muchas de las enseñanzas más importantes de Jesús que se encuentran en el Evangelio según san Mateo; procuremos que esas palabras se reflejen en nuestra propia vida.

Por la intercesión de María, la Madre de Dios, y de nuestro patrono santo Tomás, oremos por nuestra parroquia. Juntos, bendigamos a Dios por sus muchos dones y sigamos buscando su voluntad para nuestra vida y para nuestra comunidad parroquial.
