PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We're blessed to have with us a special guest at Mass this weekend:

Fr Alfred Lopez. He is a priest from the Dominican order and connected with Food for the Poor, an organization that works to relieve of international hunger. Please give him a warm welcome to our parish, as he speaks about how we can be involved in helping those in need around the world! Here is a brief introduction from him:



Fr. Lopez belongs to Dominican Province of St. Albert and was ordained in 1984. Before advocating for the poor, he taught at Northern Michigan University and Dominican College of San Rafael. He was counselor at the Departments of Clinical Social Work at the University of New Mexico Hospital. Father Lopez will share personal witness about Food For The Poor's mission to care for the destitute as a means of living out the Gospel to love one another.

As we reflect on our responsibility of being witnesses to Christ's love, I'd like to pass along a prayer from Pope Francis, found in his 2013 letter titled "The Joy of the Gospel." In it, he gives the Blessed Mother the title of "Star of the New Evangelization," and he asks us to call upon her assistance in the great project of making sure every human being knows God's love:

Mary, Virgin and Mother, Star of the new evangelization, help us to bear radiant witness to communion, service, ardent and generous faith, justice and love of the poor, that the joy of the Gospel may reach to the ends of the earth, illuminating even the fringes of our world. Mother of the living Gospel, wellspring of happiness for God's little ones, pray for us. Amen. Alleluia!

Through the intercession of Our Lady and our patron St. Thomas, let's commit to fully living out our calling to be instruments of God's mercy.

CARTA DEL SACERDOTE

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,



Tenemos la dicha de contar con un invitado especial en la Misa de este fin de semana: el Padre Alfred López. Es sacerdote de la Orden Dominicana y está conectado con Food for the Poor, una organización que trabaja para aliviar el hambre en el mundo. ¡Démosle una cálida bienvenida a nuestra parroquia! Nos hablará sobre cómo podemos participar en la ayuda a quienes lo necesitan alrededor del mundo. A continuación, una breve presentación suya:

El Padre López pertenece a la Provincia Dominicana de San Alberto y fue ordenado sacerdote en 1984. Antes de dedicarse a la defensa de los pobres, enseñó en la Universidad del Norte de Michigan y en el Colegio Dominicano de San Rafael. Fue consejero en el Departamento de Trabajo Social Clínico del Hospital de la Universidad de Nuevo México. El Padre López compartirá su testimonio personal sobre la misión de Food for the Poor de cuidar a los necesitados como una forma de vivir el Evangelio de amarnos unos a otros.

LECTURAS DEL DOMINGO

Primera Lectura: (1 Reyes 3, 5, 7-12)

En este pasaje, Salomón pide a Dios sabiduría para gobernar a su pueblo en lugar de riquezas o poder.

Salmo Responsorial (Salmo 118, 57 y 72. 76-77. 127-128. 129-130)

Este salmo expresa un profundo amor por la Palabra de Dios, reconociendo que sus enseñanzas brindan consuelo, sabiduría y dirección para vivir con fidelidad.

Segunda Lectura: (Romanos 8, 28-30)

San Pablo nos recuerda que Dios obra para el bien de quienes lo aman y los llama según su propósito.

Evangelio: (Mateo 13, 44-52)

Jesús enseña que el Reino de los Cielos es un tesoro de valor incomparable, por el cual vale la pena dejarlo todo. También nos llama a reconocer y compartir las riquezas del Reino con sabiduría.

Mientras reflexionamos sobre nuestra parte en ser testigos del amor de Cristo, me gustaría transmitir una oración del Papa Francisco, que se encuentra en su carta de 2013 titulada “La alegría del Evangelio”. En esta carta, el Santo Padre le da a la Santísima Madre el título de “Estrella de la Nueva Evangelización,” y nos pide que invoquemos su ayuda en el gran proyecto de hacer que cada ser humano conozca el amor de Dios:

Virgen y Madre María, Estrella de la nueva evangelización, ayúdanos a resplandecer en el testimonio de la comunión, del servicio, de la fe ardiente y generosa, de la justicia y el amor a los pobres, para que la alegría del Evangelio llegue hasta los confines de la tierra y ninguna periferia se prive de su luz. Madre del Evangelio viviente, manantial de alegría para los pequeños, ruega por nosotros. Amén. ¡Aleluya!

Por intercesión de Nuestra Señora y de nuestro patrón Santo Tomás, comprometámonos a vivir plenamente nuestra vocación a ser instrumentos de la misericordia de Dios.
