Dear Brothers and Sisters,



It's hard to believe that summer is winding down and the young folks are almost back to school! As we do each year, we will be doing our annual blessing of backpacks this weekend. Along with that blessing, please offer a special prayer for all of our students and teachers, that this year will be a time of growth and learning for everyone. Particularly for everyone at our parish school, we pray that the love of God will be the main lesson learned, so that our kids will grow in wisdom and grace and that together we continue to grow into a community of love. Many thanks to everyone who participates in our special second collection for the school this weekend. As we come to the end of the summer season, we also say farewell to our summer seminarian, Jonathan.
