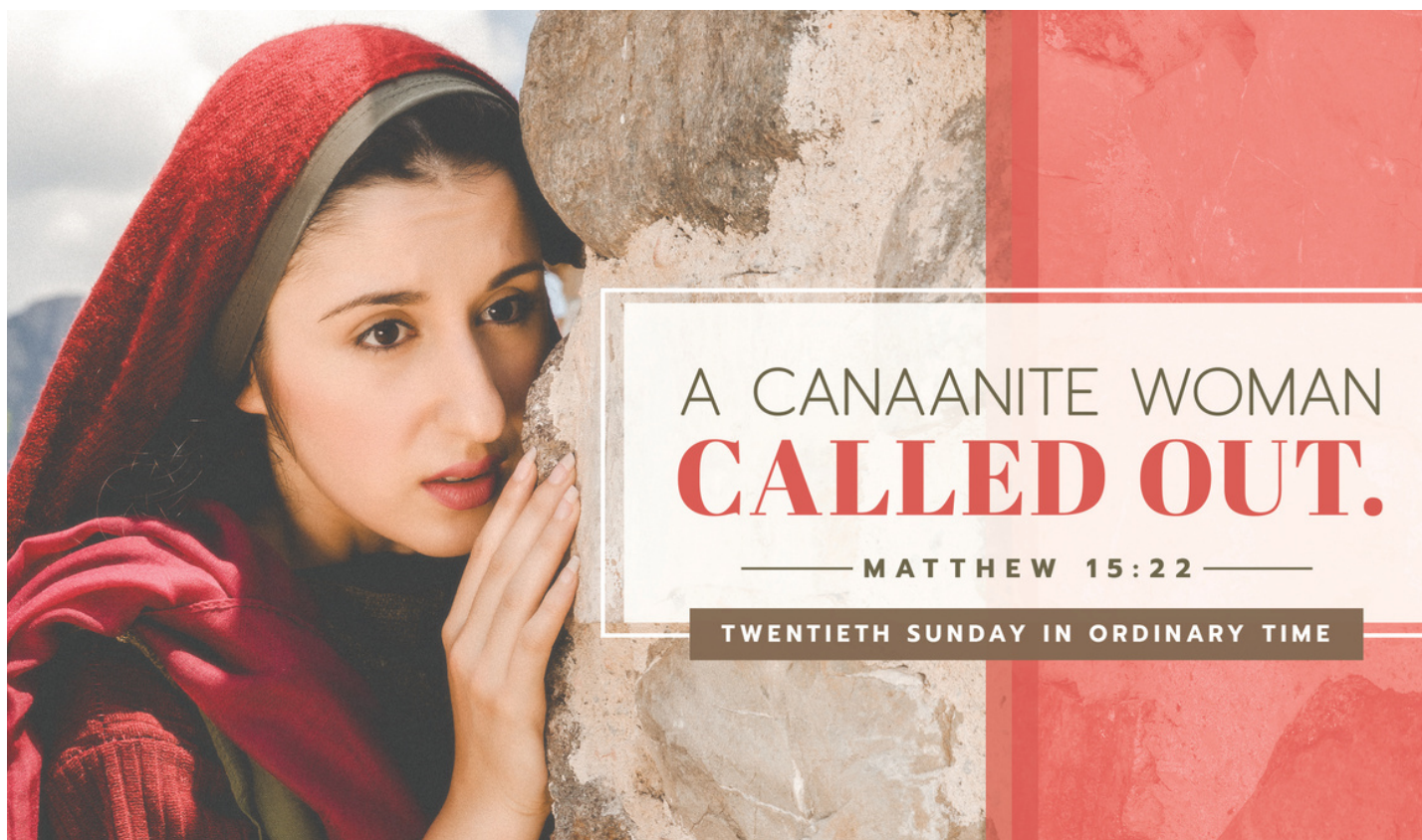

PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

There are a lot of people out there who feel like they're beyond the reach of God's love. Sometimes because of decisions they've made, and sometimes because of difficult situations they've found themselves in. When we feel that way, life becomes a burden.

And that's why it's so important for us to always remind ourselves and others that God loves everyone, no matter what we've done or what situation we're in. That's why Jesus died and rose again. He goes out of his way to make sure that we can all find our way to him and experience his loving care. We see it in today's Gospel, when Jesus reaches out across every boundary of race and culture and society to show his love for a Canaanite woman and her family.

Since we're called to have the same attitude as Christ (in other words, to share his love), it's worth thinking about whether there is anyone in our life that needs to hear that message of God's love. Maybe they're Catholic and have been away from church for a while. Or maybe they've never really known God. My encouragement to the parish this weekend is to pray for anyone you know who might be distant from God, so that they will feel drawn to his love.

Inviting people to come closer to God is on my mind this week, since we're in the process of starting our OCIA program for the year: the main way that we respond to the needs of people seeking unity with Christ and his Church. The formal program will begin the evening of Tuesday, 25 August, at 6:30pm, so we're in active outreach mode right now. Again, as a first step, please think and pray about anyone you know that might be interested—I'm sure we all know someone that has questions and would like to learn more about God. As a second step, if you feel God leading you, please give them a personal invitation to come to St. Thomas and check out our OCIA.

Through the intercession of Mary, the Mother of Apostles, and our patron St. Thomas, may we all find the wisdom and courage to bring someone in our lives to the Lord Jesus.

SUNDAY READINGS

First Reading: (Isaiah 56:1, 6-7)

Isaiah reminds us to live with justice and righteousness, promising that all who love and faithfully serve the Lord will be welcomed with joy into His holy house of prayer.

Responsorial Psalm: (Psalm 67:2-3, 5, 6, 8)

St. Paul expresses his deep love for his people and his desire that everyone come to know Christ, God's greatest gift.

Second Reading: (Romans 11:13-15, 29-32)

Paul teaches that God's gifts and calling are irrevocable, and that through His mercy and plan of salvation, He desires to show mercy to all people.

Gospel: (Matthew 15:21-28)

A Canaanite woman approaches Jesus with great faith, asking Him to heal her daughter. Despite being tested, she remains persistent, and Jesus praises her faith and grants her request.

CARTA DEL SACERDOTE



Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

Hay mucha gente que siente que ya está fuera del alcance del amor de Dios. A veces es por decisiones que tomaron; a veces es por situaciones difíciles en las que se encontraron sin buscarlas. Cuando uno se siente así, la vida se vuelve una carga muy pesada. Por eso es tan importante recordarnos a nosotros mismos —y recordarles a los demás— que Dios ama a todos, sin importar lo que hayamos hecho ni la situación en la que estemos. Para eso murió y resucitó Jesús. Él hace todo lo posible para que todos podamos encontrar el camino hacia Él y sentir su amor y su cuidado. Lo vemos en el Evangelio de hoy, cuando Jesús cruza toda frontera de raza, de cultura y de posición social para mostrarle su amor a una mujer cananea y a su familia.

Como estamos llamados a tener los mismos sentimientos que tuvo Cristo Jesús (es decir, a compartir su amor), vale la pena preguntarnos si hay alguien en nuestra vida que necesita escuchar ese mensaje del amor de Dios. Tal vez sea una persona católica que hace tiempo se alejó de la Iglesia. O tal vez sea alguien que nunca ha conocido de verdad a Dios. Mi invitación a toda la parroquia este fin de semana es esta: recemos por cualquier persona que ustedes conozcan que ande lejos de Dios, para que sienta que el amor de Él la atrae.

Ando pensando mucho esta semana en cómo invitar a otros a acercarse a Dios, porque estamos comenzando nuestro programa de OICA (OCIA, por sus siglas en inglés) para este año: la manera principal en que respondemos a las personas que buscan unirse a Cristo y a su Iglesia. El programa comienza formalmente la noche del martes 25 de agosto, a las 6:30 p.m., así que en este momento estamos en plena campaña de invitación. Les repito: el primer paso es pensar y rezar por alguna persona que ustedes conozcan y que pudiera estar interesada. Estoy seguro de que todos conocemos a alguien que tiene preguntas y que quisiera aprender más sobre Dios. El segundo paso: si sienten que Dios los está guiando, háganle una invitación personal para que venga a Santo Tomás y conozca nuestro programa de OICA.

Que por la intercesión de María, Madre de los Apóstoles, y de nuestro patrono Santo Tomás, todos encontremos la sabiduría y la valentía para llevar al Señor Jesús a alguien de nuestra vida.
