PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Brothers and Sisters,



After our readings last week led us to reflect on the way God has brought all people together into his Kingdom, this week we hear the story of how Christ made sure those many peoples would be brought into the oneness of faith. When Peter recognizes Jesus as the Messiah, Jesus gives him the special ministry of leading the Church in unity.

This passage has resonated loudly over the centuries. We hear those words of Jesus, and we can't help but think of the many successors of St Peter who have had such an incredible impact on the history of our faith. As of 2026, there have been 266 of them, from St Linus through our own Pope Leo XIV, and each of them has exercised this special ministry in ways that profoundly impact our faith. From speaking bold words of witness in times of controversy, to giving their life in witness to the Gospel in times of persecution, to exercising faithful stewardship of the Church in times of tranquility. The popes are a sign of hope and encouragement to us, as God's pilgrim people.

And yet we also know that being the Holy Father is an incredibly difficult job. There's a reason why Pope Leo is always asking for our prayers, and why Catholics customarily add a prayer for his intention to the Rosary. It is a joy to see how he is leading the Church through our challenging times with tremendous energy and creativity. So many people have been drawn closer to God through his inspiring example, and he needs our prayers. As we reflect on the promises of Christ to Peter, let's be sure to offer a special prayer for our good Pope this week.

Through the intercession of Mary, the Mother of Apostles, and our patron St. Thomas, may Pope Leo continue to be an inspiring voice of God's love and Christ's peace, for the worldwide Church and for our parish.

CARTA DEL SACERDOTE

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,



La semana pasada, las lecturas de las Escrituras nos llevaron a reflexionar sobre la forma en que Dios ha reunido a todas las personas en su Reino. Esta semana escuchamos la historia de cómo Cristo se aseguró de que todos pueblos fueran llevados a la unidad de la fe. Cuando San Pedro reconoció a Jesús como el Mesías, Jesús le dio el ministerio especial de conducir la Iglesia en unidad.

Este pasaje ha resonado con fuerza a lo largo de los siglos. Y, sin embargo, también sabemos que ser el Santo Padre es un trabajo increíblemente difícil. Hay una razón por qué el Papa León siempre pide nuestras oraciones, y por qué los católicos suelen agregar una oración por su intención al Rosario. El Papa León está guiando a la Iglesia a través de nuestros tiempos difíciles con tremenda energía y creatividad. Mucha gente se ha acercado más a Dios a través de su ejemplo inspirador, y él necesita nuestras oraciones. Mientras reflexionamos sobre las promesas de Cristo a Pedro, asegurémonos de ofrecer una oración especial por nuestro buen Papa esta semana.

Por intercesión de María, la Madre de los Apóstoles, y de nuestro patrón Santo Tomás, que el Papa León continúe siendo una voz inspiradora del amor de Dios y la paz de Cristo, para la Iglesia mundial y para nuestra parroquia.
