## PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Since the school year is officially off to a start, I wanted to give a couple updates to the parish about a few of our educational missions.

First, the school year for our parish school is well underway! It's a tremendous joy and a privilege to see the faces of our first students each day, and I think everyone's heart melts when we see them in their uniforms. To everyone who has supported the school through prayer, stewardship, and volunteering, thank you so much. There's still a lot of work to do to extend the promise of Catholic education to all parishioners for years to come, but I'm confident that God who has begun this good work here will continue to sustain us.

Second, the University of Montevallo is back in session, with the campus ministry in full swing. For any new university students who might be reading this, let me extend a special invitation to join us for "Spirit Night" each week: Wednesday at 5:30pm, with Mass, a home-cooked meal, and a time of fellowship and Bible study. Come join us! And for any parishioners who would like to be involved in campus ministry, we're always looking for members of our campus ministry teams. If you're interested, just reach out to Sister Amanda Magdalena.

Third, we will be kicking off our Faith Formation year very soon. Open House will be on September the 5th, and the first day of classes will be September the 6th!). As always, many thanks to all our parents who are committed to walking with the parish in passing on the Catholic faith to your children. I've had the opportunity to see so many of our young people grow in their knowledge and love of Christ through this important ministry. Thank you, as well, to our team of catechists who make a radical and important commitment to being another link in the chain to bring God's love to all.

Fourth, a reminder to everyone about our new nursery ministry during the 8am and 11am Masses. Obviously, children are always welcome at Mass, but we also realize that sometimes parents would like a short break to focus on the liturgy. This is also a great way for the littlest ones (under 5 years old) to have some basic catechesis at their level. You'll find the drop-off and pick-up over in the school building each Sunday.

Through the intercession of Mary, the Mother of Apostles, and our patron St. Thomas, let's continue to live this year of mission, with a spirit of wonder at the great things God is doing among us.

### Gospel: (Matthew 16:21-27)

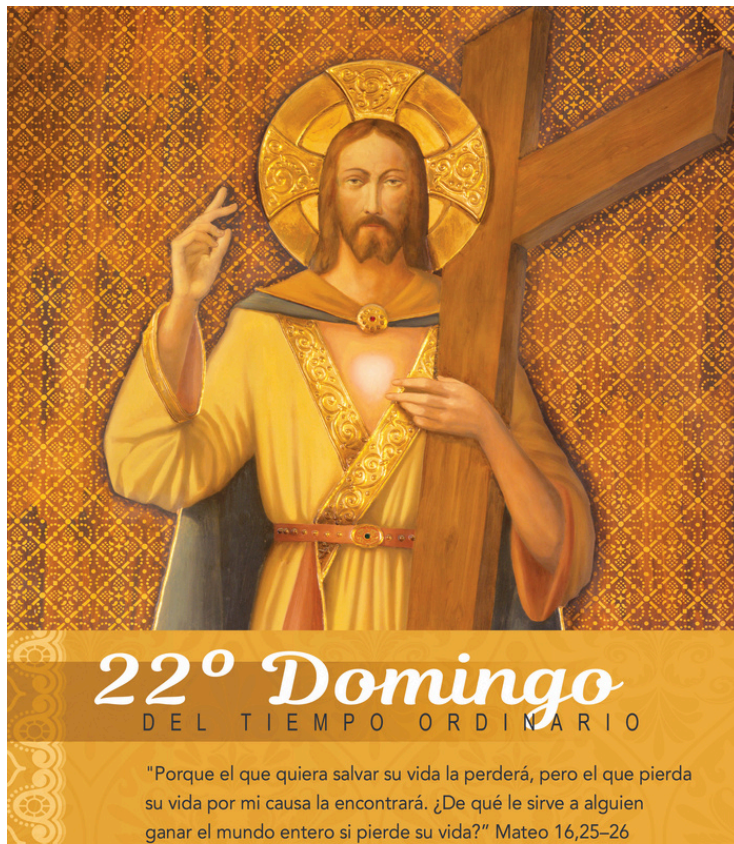
