# PRAYER & MINISTRY

## SUNDAY READINGS

### First Reading: (Sirach 27:30—28:7)

Sirach teaches us to let go of anger and resentment, choosing forgiveness instead.

### Responsorial Psalm: (Psalm 103:1-2, 3-4, 9-10, 11-12)

Psalm 103 reminds us to praise the Lord and never forget His blessings. He forgives our sins, shows us mercy and compassion, and removes our transgressions as far as the east is from the west.

### Second Reading: (Romans 14:7-9)

Paul reminds us that we do not live or die for ourselves, but for the Lord. Whether we live or die, we belong to Christ, who died and rose again so that He may be Lord of all.

### Gospel: (Matthew 18:21-35)

Jesus teaches us that we must forgive others from the heart, not just once but again and again. Just as God forgives our sins with mercy, we are called to show that same mercy to others.
