PASTOR'S LETTER

Dear Brothers and Sisters,



There's a lot of energy in the air right now at St. Thomas! The Faith Formation program is back in full swing, and it's been great to have the kids back in the classrooms learning their faith. God has truly blessed our community, and I'm so grateful to be with the people of this parish in this season of mission and witness.

Our Gospel this week is an especially memorable one. It's a parable about a landowner who hires workers at different points in the day, and to everyone's surprise, pays everyone equally, regardless of how many hours they worked. It works on many levels, but I'm especially struck by the grumbling of the early crew, who felt like they deserved more. Even if they ended up doing more work than average, they should have been glad for the extra help in working the vineyard!

Although we're not officially into our Stewardship Month of October, this parable letter gives me a chance to highlight one upcoming opportunity for generosity that's very important to our Diocese: the Bishop's Annual Appeal, traditionally known in Alabama as Catholic Charities. For those who are new to our area, or who are new to the Catholic Church, this drive is the annual appeal from our Bishop to support a number of important Catholic ministries and social services in our area. There are lots of national organizations out there with similar names, but this one is purely local. When you hear about our Diocese helping out victims of natural disasters or providing services to those in need, much of that funding comes through the annual appeal. The funds also assist with many diocesan ministries. Of note here at St Thomas, I would note that our Campus Ministry is funded in part through this collection. In other words, this an exceptionally worthwhile charity that makes a huge difference for people right here in Alabama.

You should be receiving a letter and pledge card about it from the Diocese very soon, and I would encourage everyone to prayerfully consider being part of it this year. Last year, our parish raised nearly \$60,000 for this campaign. Many thanks to everyone who took part. Your generosity continues to make a difference for so many people in need. We'll talk about it at Mass next Sunday, as well, plus have pledge cards available for anyone who didn't receive them in the mail. Thank you to everyone for the many ways that you look out for the needs of our parish, our Church, and our neighbors. Through the intercession of St. Thomas and Blessed Mary, Ever-Virgin, let's continue to be committed to service of the Lord and each other.

CARTA DEL SACERDOTE

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,



¡Se siente mucho entusiasmo en Santo Tomás en estos días! El programa de Formación en la Fe ya comenzó de nuevo con toda la fuerza, y ha sido una alegría ver a los niños en las clases, aprendiendo su fe. Dios de verdad ha bendecido a nuestra comunidad, y le doy muchas gracias por poder estar con ustedes, el pueblo de esta parroquia, en este tiempo de misión y de testimonio.

El Evangelio de este domingo es uno que no se olvida fácilmente. Es la parábola del propietario que sale a contratar trabajadores para su viña a diferentes horas del día. Al final, para sorpresa de todos, les paga lo mismo a todos, sin importar cuántas horas trabajó cada uno. Esta parábola nos enseña muchas cosas, pero a mí me llaman mucho la atención los primeros trabajadores, los que empezaron desde temprano y comenzaron a reclamarle al propietario porque sentían que merecían más. Es verdad que ellos soportaron por más tiempo el peso del día y del calor. Pero aun así, ¡debieron alegrarse de que llegara más gente a ayudarles a trabajar la viña!

Todavía no estamos en octubre, que es nuestro Mes de la Corresponsabilidad, pero esta parábola me da la oportunidad de hablarles de una forma de ser generosos que es muy importante para nuestra diócesis: la Campaña Anual del Obispo (en inglés, Bishop's Annual Appeal), que aquí en Alabama tradicionalmente se conoce como Catholic Charities (Caridades Católicas). Para quienes son nuevos en Alabama, esta es la campaña que nuestro Obispo hace cada año para apoyar varios ministerios católicos y servicios sociales muy importantes en nuestra región. Cuando oyen que nuestra diócesis está ayudando a las víctimas de un desastre natural o atendiendo a personas necesitadas, mucho de ese dinero viene de esta campaña anual. Estos fondos también apoyan muchos otros ministerios de la diócesis. Por ejemplo, muchas de las iniciativas diocesanas en el campo de ministerio hispano están apoyadas por esta ofrenda. En pocas palabras, es una obra de caridad que vale mucho la pena y que hace mucho bien a la gente aquí mismo en Alabama.

Muy pronto van a recibir por correo una carta y una tarjeta de compromiso de parte de la diócesis. Los invito a todos a que lo piensen en oración y consideren participar este año. El año pasado, nuestra parroquia reunió casi 60,000 dólares para esta campaña. ¡Muchas gracias a todos los que participaron! Su generosidad sigue haciendo mucho bien a tantas personas necesitadas. Vamos a hablar más de esto en la Misa del próximo domingo, y también vamos a tener tarjetas de compromiso para quienes no las recibieron por correo.

Gracias a todos por las muchas maneras en que cuidan de las necesidades de nuestra parroquia, de nuestra Iglesia y de nuestro prójimo. Por la intercesión de Santo Tomás y de Santa María, siempre Virgen, sigamos comprometidos a servir al Señor y a servirnos unos a otros.
