She studied Graphic Techniques and Illustration at the Institute of NTUU KPI, Kyiv, Ukraine (2003-2007); Fine Art at the École Nationale Supérieure d'Art de Dijon, Dijon, France (2008); and Monumental Painting at the National Academy of Fine Art and Architecture, Kyiv, Ukraine (2008-2015). She is a member of preservation group for the photolegacy of the Hutsul naïve artist Paraska Plytka-Horytsvit. Since 2016 she works with people with autism spectrum disorders in inclusive art studio 'Workshop of Possibilities'. In 2024 she presents 'Best Wishes' project in the Ukrainian Pavilion at the 60th International Venice Biennale together with 15 neurodivergent artists.
