to dress up as Vikings and also to closely observe lots of different Viking artifacts.


After the workshop, they also got to visit the Palace's playground.

Dear Parents and Carers of children in Nursery and Reception,


We are pleased to announce that **each half term**, we will be holding a parent and carer workshop for you to be able to attend.
