MATHS

Write and describe some number patterns e.g.,

126, 116, 106, 96 *the pattern is 10 less*
5, 105, 205, 305 *the pattern is 100 more*

SPELLING

Revise the spelling of the long -o- vowel sound.

*goal **home** coat **go** cold*
*follow own ghost **snow***
joke whole goes

If your child has difficulty learning spellings, concentrate on the **bold spellings **
