## Maths

This week in maths we have been looking at:

- Choosing the correct operation (**addition or subtraction**)
- Using pictures to solve word problems.

For your home learning this week can you practice telling number stories to someone at home.

**E.g I have 5 sweets and I gave 2 to Mummy. How many do I have left?**

Can you orally rehearse your word problems with an adult? You could even draw a picture to go with your number story.



You can also log on to MyMaths (**login is in your reading record**) to practise counting to 10 using objects, numerals and words.

## Phonics/spelling

This half-term we are focusing on **Phase 4 revision** in Phonics as well as recapping our CEWs.

For your home learning this week have a go at these spellings:

## Reading


**Try to remember to read your book for 10 minutes everyday.**

For your home learning this week have a go at researching the life cycle of another animal.


**You could research the life cycle of a:**
