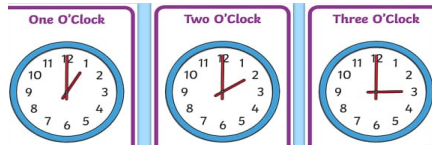


Year 1 Home Learning 16th April 2026

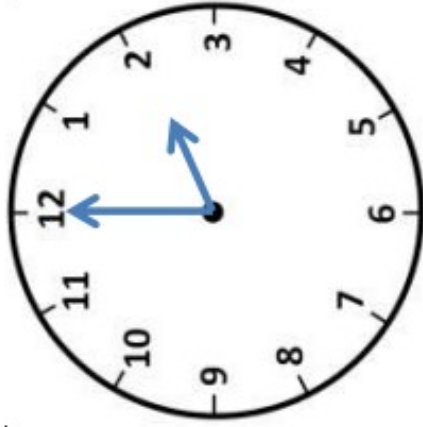


This week we started our new topic- 'Let's be Farmers'

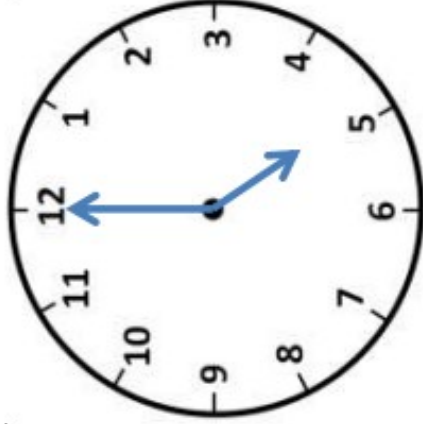
For your home learning this week have a go at writing some 'I can see' sentences about the farm picture.

Remember to use lots of amazing adjectives to make your sentences longer and more interesting.

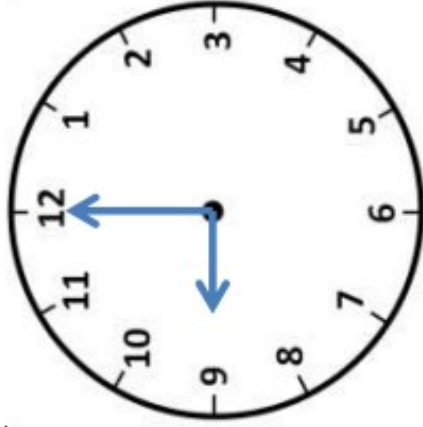
