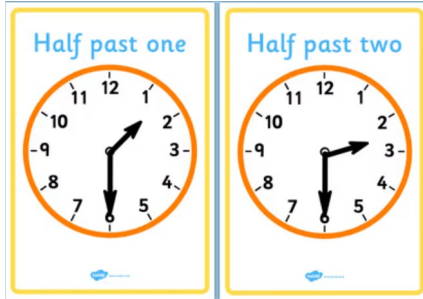


Year 1 Home Learning 23rd April 2026
