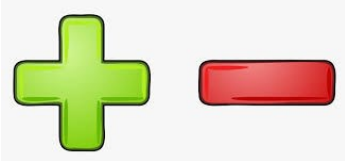


Year 1 Home Learning 7th May 2026

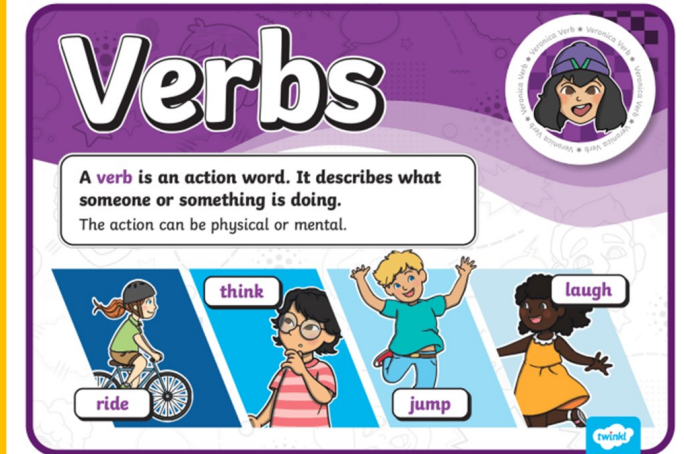
Remember to keep practicing all the sounds we have learnt all the way from Phase 2 to Phase 5.
