We used our number line to count on – This means starting from the 1st number in our number sentence.



$$\underline{5} + 2 = 7$$

You could find out facts about:

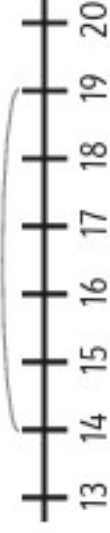
- Foods from your country
