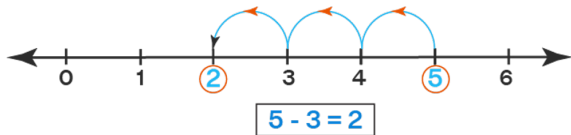


Year 1 Home Learning 11th June 2026
