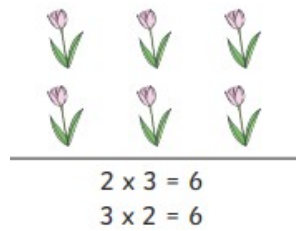


Year 1 Home Learning 2nd July 2026

5. **Where does it live?**





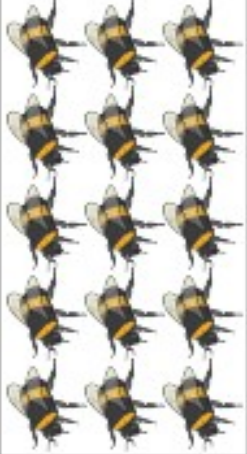
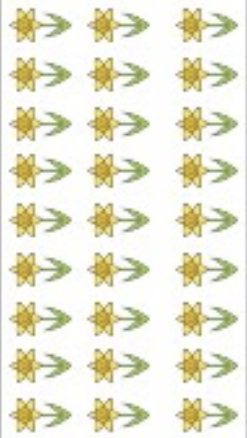
Spring-Themed Multiplication
