


THE STORY OF MEDITERRANEAN FJORD

The driver and the professional guide will pick up the clients at the accommodation and they will start their full day excursion to explore the picturesque Boka Kotorska Bay. One of the Mediterranean's most distinctive and striking landscapes, Boka Kotorska bay sits in the Adriatic Sea, enveloped in mountains towering up to 1700 meters above the water. Its jewel, Kotor, sits under a rugged curtain of medieval stone walls, proudly showcasing its distinctly Venetian heritage and vibrant present-day atmosphere. Not far from there, a tiny, dreamy island called Our Lady of the Rock houses a church of the same name and accentuates the waterfront of Perast.

One of the Mediterranean's most distinctive and striking landscapes, Boka Kotorska bay sits in the Adriatic Sea, enveloped in mountains towering up to 1700 meters above the water. Upon visiting the famous Kotor Old Town, we will embark on the speedboat at Kotor Marina and see the bay from a totally different perspective. First stop is a dreamy island called Our Lady of the Rock, which accentuates the waterfront of Perast.

Highlighting the main treasures of Boka Kotorska bay, this tour not only introduces you to its stunning nature, but to an array of distinct cultural treasures: venerated churches, elegant palaces, informative museums, pompous gates and some blood-stirring stairs. We will have a stop at the "Oyster farm" for an optional degustation and continue visiting Island St. Marko and Bay of Tivat.

At the end, we arrive at the famous Marina Porto Montenegro — the final point of the speedboat tour, where you can enjoy lunch at one of the renowned restaurants and visit the Submarine Museum for stories of Montenegrin naval history. After lunch – return to the accommodation by luxury vehicle with a panoramic drive.


MONTENEGRIN HERITAGE BEHIND THE BLACK MOUNTAINS

For most people, Montenegrin culture is not well known, so this experience will take you deep into history and introduce you to amazing and authentic places. The tour with a professional guide and luxury vehicle starts at sea level and takes you to the very heart of Montenegro — the land behind the mystical black mountains, where the sea is just a distant promise and an entirely different history was written.

The Old Royal Capital of Montenegro, Cetinje, was founded in the 15th century and still retains its significance as the official residence of the country's President. Among many historic venues, you will visit King Nikola's Palace and Cetinje Monastery — home to two major Christian relics: the hand of Saint John the Baptist and a piece of the Holy Cross.

Refreshments will be served in the ethno village of Njeguši, birthplace of King Njegoš, where the highlight is the famous Montenegrin prosciutto (smoked ham). You'll learn about the production process and raise a toast with a glass of the local "love potion". Then, we head to Lovćen National Park and the summit where the iconic Mausoleum stands — a cultural and panoramic highlight. Afterwards, enjoy a traditional lunch with an unforgettable view over Boka Bay. The tour concludes with a drive down the famous Lovćen serpentines.

THE BEAUTIFUL MONTENEGRO TOUR

Some guests only stay in Montenegro for a few days — this spectacular excursion is the perfect way to experience the country's best in just one day. It is a powerful combination of history, culture, adrenaline and gastronomy.

The tour with a professional guide and luxury vehicle begins at the coast with a visit to the magnificent Kotor Old Town. From there, you'll drive up the scenic serpentine to the Old Royal Capital of Cetinje. You'll visit King Nikola's Palace and the Cetinje Monastery. A tasting break follows in the ethno village of Njeguši, known for its famous Montenegrin prosciutto — also the birthplace of King Njegoš.

Next stop: River Crnojevića — a former key trading post and now one of Montenegro's most scenic spots. Located in Skadar Lake National Park, the village is the starting point for a tranquil boat ride. You'll glide past overgrown shores, dreamy bays and islands with ancient sacred monuments while enjoying local fritters, cheese, honey and wine. For wine lovers, we recommend a stop at a local family estate for a wine tasting and homemade lunch with fresh fish from the lake and river.

On the way back, a photo stop is made at Montenegro's postcard icon — the island of Sveti Stefan — the perfect place to end the day with the sunset.

MEDITATIVE WONDER OF THE WILD: SKADAR LAKE

The driver and guide will pick up the clients at their accommodation and take them to Skadar Lake. With a surface of 391 square kilometers, Skadar is the largest lake on the Balkan Peninsula. Thanks to its geographic position and sub-Mediterranean climate, 280 bird species call it home, making it the second most important swamp bird habitat in Europe, right after the Danube Delta. As you listen to their chanting, keep an eye out for the rare curly pelican — the emblem of the National Park.

As the lulling photo safari takes you around its overgrown shores, dreamy bays and mystic islands with holy monuments, snack on traditional Montenegrin fritters, cheese and honey, paired with a glass of local wine. A magical afternoon on Skadar Lake soothes, inspires, and relaxes.

The tour includes a visit to a local, authentic winery where you'll taste excellent local specialties. Then, enjoy a wooden boat ride along River Crnojevića — once the most important trading center in Montenegro. In the tranquil lakeside village, you'll have lunch with freshly caught lake fish and soak in the peace of this unique setting. Return after lunch.

GASTRONOMY TOUR WITHIN THE BAY OF KOTOR

The driver and professional guide will pick up the clients at their accommodation. The tour begins with a visit to Kotor Old Town — a UNESCO site rich in history and architecture. Here, you'll enjoy a tasting of a "secret specialty" known among locals.

Next, the journey continues to an oyster farm near Perast. You'll learn about oyster farming and enjoy a fresh tasting experience directly by the sea. The serene waterfront setting and traditional methods will make this stop especially memorable.

The final stop is at the "Savina" winery, located near the Savina Monastery in Herceg Novi. With a winemaking tradition dating back to the 18th century, Savina offers a story intertwined with Venetian heritage. You'll enjoy a wine tasting with local delicacies and a stunning view of the bay. This gentle landscape, authentic rural architecture, and the hospitality of the locals create a unique experience.

On the return, a short stop in Portonovi is planned for a relaxing seaside walk to close the experience.

MONASTERY OSTROG

The driver and professional guide will pick up the clients at their accommodation and the tour will begin with a panoramic ride along the coast and several scenic viewpoint and photo stops on the way to Monastery Ostrog.

Located at an altitude of around 900 meters, the Monastery is built into a vertical cliff face. In winter months, reaching it can be a challenge even for the most experienced travelers. Despite its unusual position, Ostrog is one of the most visited Christian pilgrimage sites in the world. This 17th-century Orthodox monastery is the spiritual heart of Montenegro.

The highlight is the cave-like Church of the Presentation, which has remained untouched since its founding and houses the relics of Saint Basil of Ostrog. A powerful insight into monastic life, this living monastery reflects the country's religious heritage, tradition and timeless faith.

A traditional lunch can be arranged in a local restaurant near the Monastery, offering both hearty food and stunning views.




MYSTERIES OF THE UNDERWORLD: LIPA CAVE




THE CAPITAL CITY PODGORICA

The driver and professional guide will pick up the clients at their accommodation and the tour will begin with a panoramic ride of the seaside and several viewpoints and photo stops on the way to Podgorica!

The capital of Montenegro, Podgorica, is a compact and comfortable city that blends many contrasts into a harmony. As you stroll around, admire Christian monasteries, ancient mosques, and medieval churches like the 10th century George Church. Brutalist structures from the Yugoslav era stand side by side with the castle of King Nikola and contemporary, glass-and-steel buildings. All this along the banks of the scenic River Morača, on the brinks of centuries-old forests! Explore the city, and if you wish, pop into a museum or two, like the Archaeological Research Center or the Museum of Natural History. It is great to combine it with a visit to national wine production company "Plantaže" and its own wine cellar "Šipčanik" where we can arrange the sightseeing and tasty degustation of several wines and national snacks.

DUBROVNIK TOUR

Dubrovnik – the pearl of Adriatic and UNESCO world heritage – a city with stunning beauty has to be seen and explored. A professional guide will start the tour from the main entrance to the Old Town – Pile Gate. Dubrovnik's Old Town historical sights are remarkable and fascinating, they are a part of its ancestors' rich heritage. That makes Dubrovnik a living monument.

The Old Town, which is a pedestrian zone, includes main historical sites such as: Stradun or Placa – the Old Town's main street, Sponza or Dogana – one of the most important buildings in the town used as a customs house, the Franciscan Monastery with a museum containing the Old Pharmacy's inventory, the Dominican Monastery, Rector's Palace (the residence of every rector in the Dubrovnik Republic), the Cathedral, Orlando's Column, St. Blasius Church and many more.

Sightseeing in Dubrovnik with a professional guide lasts approximately 2 hours, and after that our suggestion is to take a walk on the ancient City Walls by yourself or accompanied by a private guide.

The walls, built back in the 13th century, still retain their shape and condition today. They are 1,940 meters long and consist of the main city walls, sixteen towers, three fortresses, six bastions, two corner fortifications, three bulwarks with rows of turrets, three moats, two flank fortresses, one breakwater, and two drawbridges.

DISCOVER ALBANIA

Meet at least a tiny part of Albania, the enigma we all know. Already on your way to the border, there live some Albanians in little villages. This is the world that preserved a traditional patriarchal way of life, its typical architecture as well as culture. Olive trees surround the Muslim villages by the Bojana River that represents the natural border between Montenegro and Albania.

From here we are going to Tirana, capital of Albania. You can ride a cable car to Dajti mountain, 1,800 m above sea level. Tirana is the capital and largest city of Albania.

Lively, colorful Tirana is the beating heart of Albania. Having undergone a transformation of extraordinary proportions since it awoke from its communist slumber in the early 1990s, Tirana's centre is now unrecognizable, with its buildings painted in primary colors and public squares and pedestrianized streets a pleasure to wander.

The renovated National Art Gallery, the new Post Blloku memorial on the main boulevard and the spruced-up Grand Park are all additional reasons to visit Tirana. On the way back, possible stop for free time in Shkoder, upon request!


ACTIVITIES

“THE TEAR OF EUROPE” RAFTING

The maximum speed you are allowed to achieve is 100 km/h, which makes it the most extreme zipline in the country. 
