

STUDENT ACCESS TO CKS ONLINE RESOURCES AT HOME


We have a GMail account set up for all students from Kindergarten and up. Depending on your child's grade, an account for one or more online services, such as IXL and AR, have been set up. If the student is logged into a Chrome browser with their school credentials, they should have access to "CKS Bookmarks" on the browser bookmarks bar (see below), consisting of a collection of bookmarks to commonly accessed online curricular materials and resources.

The instructions below will allow a student to log into his/her CKS student account to access the same online resources available on school-issued Chromebooks. These instructions assume you're using the Chrome browser on a Windows or Mac computer, but other browsers may work as well. If the student is logging into a home Chromebook, they may log in just as they do at school. If you need to find your student's Google login information, you can find it via the [Family Portal](#) or FACTS Family App under **School | Web Forms | Student Credentials**. If you do not already have a Family Portal login account established, follow the directions at the following link:

Here are instructions for logging into your student's Google account on Chrome browser:

- 1) To sign into the student's Google account, go to <https://www.google.com>
- 2)
 - a) If you're not already signed into Google, you'll click the Sign In button, and log in with your student's Google credentials:

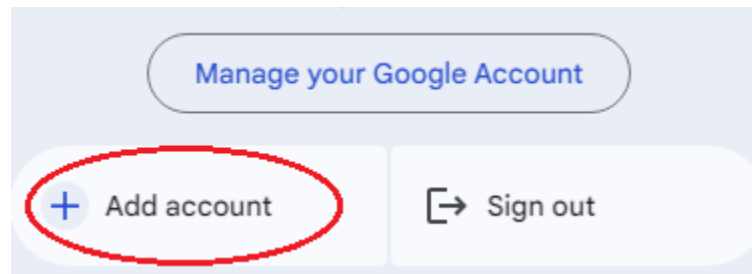

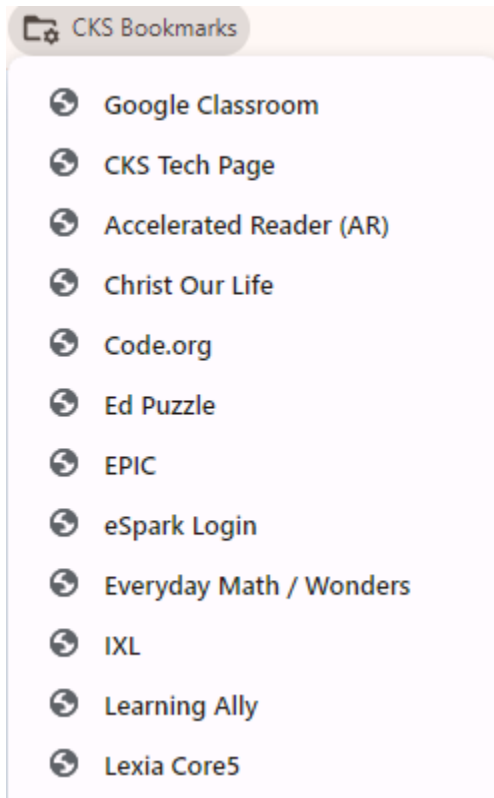

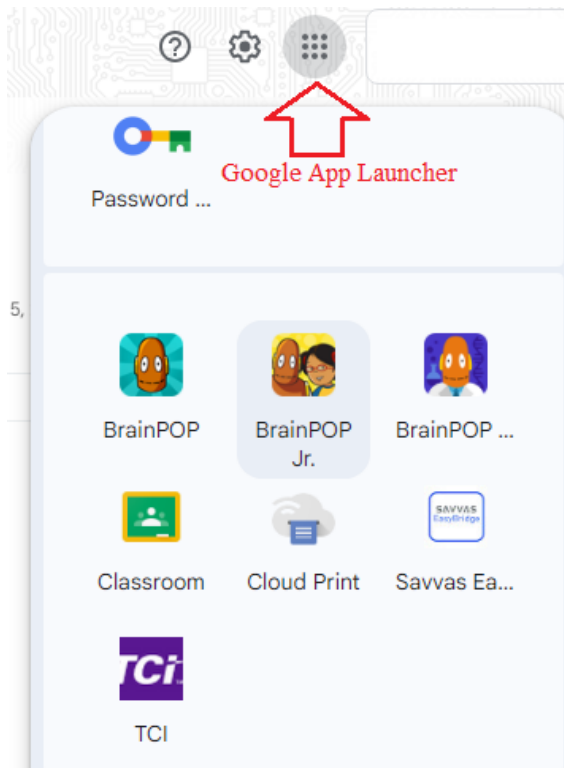

- b) If you're already logged in, click on your profile icon in the top-right corner of the browser window, then click the Add Account button, and proceed to log in with your student's Google credentials.:

- 3) Once your student is logged into their school profile, they'll see the CKS Bookmarks button on the browser's bookmarks bar, and the Google App Launcher menu will have all the same apps available:





Here are a few service-specific notes regarding login credentials:

- Google services require the school email address as the username, and the full, eight-character password as shown in RenWeb.
- For most non-Google services for which CKS creates accounts, drop the “AG” from the end of the Gmail password, and use the non-Google username;
- Some non-Google services have Google Single Sign-on (SSO) enabled, which allows the student to use their existing Google account to log in to those services without providing additional credentials.
- The first time a student logs into IXL on a particular device, you must append “@ctkschool” (without the quotes) to the end of the non-Google username. Upon successful login, you’ll be prompted to save the custom login information, and once you do that, the “@ctkschool” suffix will automatically appear for subsequent logins, and you can use the non-Google username only thereafter.
